

WE ARE UNSTUDIED CHAPTER 2 THE GREAT CONTRADICTION

I was considering another title for this book, when the Lord stepped in with His suggestion. “Ignorance Makes Things Harder.” I understood straight off what he meant.

His reasons are clear and concise. It is so simple. And He means to present the context of this book in that light. Not that we have done so much wrong, but it is a fact that ignorance makes things harder. It has been my experience to admit these things to the Lord and He makes it very easy for Him to then educate me. Rabbi.

In life, and particularly in this area of study. The real fun is when we realize we have been ignorant and begin to learn. New doors are bound to open.

Throughout 1700 years of church services we have discarded most of what the word says about ministry and ministry gifts, and have majored on a few scriptures. This is lazy. And wrongly interpreted. A trick.

Hegiomai the first miss. This miss has cost millions of souls. They are feeling the heat. Important quote from heaven concerning just this...
“The enemy has morphed this scripture into a distorted form- this is how generations have read it. He has taken this one scripture and

rammed it down the throats of Christians while simultaneously creating a blatant disregard for the study and application of Ephesians 4”

I stand in awe as I give you this quote from heaven. As one who is in awe of His clarity. As one who will never ever pen anything of more importance.

I find it very exciting and enlightening to explore where the enemy has been lurking. We are going on an adventure like Edison and discovering something brand new.

This ignorance I am describing has resulted in our lazy application of all the ministry gifts and fullness of what God has intended for us .

The laze is driven by a few scriptures misunderstood.

To be ignorant is not to know so. We need to examine the word. To begin to question our own surety is the best start. To care more than we have been drives us even closer.

This is not to say ministry does not exist. This is to say, it does not yet exist in ALL of us. It does not exist yet in its fullness of power because it does not include the entire body of Christ. I will prove this biblically throughout.

Quote from heaven....

“Generations have read Hebrews 13:17 in a distorted form.... this scripture has been taught in a distorted form.” We will examine and expound in detail the correct form and interpretation in this chapter. We have been double crossed- hoodwinked- wool over eyes with a false song on the true meaning of Hegiomai.

It was meant to be understood as a child. Simplicity. Or that a child could understand it. Or even that we become as a child after our understanding arrives. Children are important and He wants them to understand the word in its simplicity. The distortion has brought fear and strictness through a military stance. The enemy has used ignorance for his purposes.

Children hold a great importance in His kingdom. Isaiah 11:6..”A child shall lead them.” Matt 19:14.... “But Jesus said, suffer (allow) little children and forbid them not, to come unto Me, for such is the kingdom of heaven.”

This book is not meant to be endless criticism. It is a revelation of truth. The Word states the truth and that will set you free. Jesus said He is the truth, the life, the way. Isn't it just His way? It is not a forced understanding that I am presenting, but a genuine and gentle unfolding. A clearer view. A more solid ground.

From which we may launch our freedom. He is all about freedom. Only the best for His family. A shaking and unshackling of the old.

Once understanding and wisdom arrive, He will give you what He has always been willing and waiting to give you. Your unique service and ministry for His kingdom.

Author's note: you will notice throughout some repeating themes. While not advisable from an editorial point of view, I have risked redundancy. I have left this aspect of the book intentionally woven in as a matter of great importance worthy of the emphasis. These are topics seldom discussed and certainly not at this depth. It won't hurt to hear some of it repeated. It may increase retention.

Truth that has been covered needs exposure in order for change to occur. Emerging from dark corners the enemy may incite doubt and even persecution. Please keep reading. We have the word of God expounded to keep us not only grounded, but founded in truth. It will confirm our darkest and deepest doubts.

I will be exposing in this first chapter, a great contradiction. It has existed in the world of Christianity and in my mind for years. Something was not right. I knew it. The unveiling came with the acceptance of my Godly purpose. I understood my initial insights were linked to the revelation I was to receive. Through that fulfilling and then years of study. Which was a sheer delight. He is not heavy.

I will be exposing throughout this journal to you profound truths that have been suffocated by profound lies for centuries. I would find it an interesting read myself if I were not the author.

BASED ON A FEW SCRIPTURES quote from Papa- the first of many
What exactly is “based on a few scriptures ?” The entire way we do
church ! In fact, it is sending thousands to hell in a day !!

We are marching into a Sunday service based on a few scriptures ! It is
not the full counsel of God which would look a lot different !

If we do not believe that the will of the enemy can begin disaster in such
small ways, consider this....

The entire notion of slavery and the entire civil war began from a few 2
or 3 greedy men who agreed on a plan ! This is what the Lord revealed to
me when I was pondering the origins of such evil.

Hebrews 13:17 Obey them that have the rule over you and submit
yourselves,

Now He has also shown me this one scripture in much the same way, the
enemy has sunk the entire Christian body into submission that results in
very little ministry.

The usual interpretation is to submit to pastoral authority, for they must
give an accounting - make it easy on them. This is a false interpretation
and this chapter will take you through every word of it.

MISERY

We in essence, submit to nothing. There are no real results to submit to a
leader. It does not lead anywhere. There is no employee. In fact,
throughout history any leader employed his soldiers, workers etc. There is

no realization of your part and contribution. There is no real purpose which is why it creates misery. It is a false notion. Submit simply means to listen to the word of God. It does not mean to forsake your purpose in Christ and your ministry and let one person do everything. To find purpose in God is the most exciting thing a child of God can realize. It is a never ending relationship that succeeds. His investment in us is greater than we have realized. He cannot give it to us in good part, because of the distortion of this one scripture.

Everything we have today is a translation. Certain words have been translated poorly or over time, or by someone with motives contrary to God's best intent. This means to go back to the original Greek will give us the purest and truest form of the word that our Lord intended.

“ This one scripture has been rammed down the throats of believers and given license to ignoring the rest of what the bible says about ministry.”

Another very important quote. How little we know because of this.

All three parts of Hebrews 13:17 scripture mean something else than what we have believed them to. We have based them on our experience in church. We have fit our experience” which is earthly and transitory to actually fit into the word “ my quote. Here we are finally looking at these scriptures in their truest form; and discerning a different set of rules. The original Greek is our best friend. It shows us the pure truth separate from the authority of man.

What we are going to study has been misunderstood. Hidden.

WHY STUDY

Our Lord would never have given us a Bible that was too difficult to understand. It is easy enough for a child and yet has hints of complexity that engage the adult to puzzle a few things out.

- 1) We are instructed to rightly divide the word of truth.
- 2) To know the difference between the old and new covenant text is essential as the new has brought a great change. This is pivotal for our understanding of our new role. This determines how we function as New Testament Christians. Realize the enemy of God is interested in keeping us the old so we will not obtain the benefits of the new. Realize I am about to expose him in every chapter of this journal.
- 3) How we read is important. Our attitude in any biblical study will determine our growth or lack of it. Matthew 11:18-23 Jesus describes our attitudes that can fail. Read in faith the word is alive to us in the present.
- 4) The same word or phrase can have 2 different meanings in two different chapters or or two different books in

the bible. For this reason the origin of the word will have great impact. All words are defined by their context. It is essential to research the original Greek. For example, did you know that the phrase “in the beginning” in Genesis holds a different meaning in John chapter 1? This can be a great unlocking of misunderstanding. One that has been overlooked.

5) Who is the text addressing? Salutations should never be overlooked. Is it intended and addressed to an elder, a new christian or the saints at Ephesus? Our interpretation of a text can become smeared into a whole other function and purpose if we are not looking at WHO that passage is intended for.

6) Realize kings of ancient days have translated the word to their advantage in the past to extract payments. The word has been abused. We are taking a hard look at that in this journal. Some have omitted researching the original Greek as well as an in depth study in order to conform to tradition. This includes versions of the bible.

7) It is important to study the word in context to gain the fullness of understanding. Snippets have been used by cults

to create new meanings. We were never meant to read this way. A heart seeking after God will find Him in His word.

8) Follow what Jesus and the first apostles did in his ministry as an example for us. It is vital not to view them as ones who founded what we have today. Or memorialized in history, a museum or admire them from a stained glass window. The word is alive and is meant to work for us today.

9) Tradition is too readily defended over the word of God. Know the difference and discern it. The word becomes rushed and simplistic when we jam our experience into the word. This comes from following founding fathers that were not the apostles in the Bible. The word is never meant to be conformed to our experience or rushed. This creates dark roots that are then defended. It is meant to be studied and accepted as a body of believers whose fruit will be ministry or the release of ministry.

10) The more we study the gifts of ministry the more we will get our gifts of ministry. He is waiting to fulfill His word.

11) Timelines and generations are meant to reveal truth. They give us a glimpse into the nature and timing of God. He is eternal and his processes are not carnal. His reasons and

timing can be understood and when they are we gain more patience in our walk with Him. Jesus came at the exact time Galatians 4:4 When the fulness of time had come God sent forth his son born of a woman born as Jew. Genealogy is important. It ties things together. Jewish scholars who lived 500 BC who wrote the Torah had oral tradition. Think about this- they recorded it “without” the new testament and this inhibited their understanding of Genesis. There is more information in John-1 Cor- Adam a living soul-Jesus the second Adam.

12) Look for help from other Christians not from the world. Who have shallow interpretations.

13) Realize we are meant to take time with the word of God. It is the lazy rush that will cause us to forfeit its fullness. To insist our tradition into the word is our most grievous mistake. Bringing a oneness of understanding resulting in ministry is our true maturity.

14) Tie scriptures together to find meaning and you will find they eventually fit like a puzzle. The word is actually complete. However, it prompts our study. Even if that means comparative study. It will create a beautiful embroidery of truth containing both the greatest common sense and the

greatest love. Fear Him and you have found the beginning of wisdom. Love His word and we have found life.

15) Realize the enemy has his finger in every pot and is interested in confusion, misinterpretation and he has relied on our laziness to steal. He will steal valuable lessons and even our future in God through a clever use of semantics.

16) Our growth and grown-up function depends on study and then application of the word individually and then collectively. It is meant to spring us forth into service to Him. Following His seed and anointing after study of the ministry gifts is yet to be learned and has not yet become the general experience of the church.

17) Realize this journal is about exposing our over estimation of our knowledge and our understudy. The fruit of ministry is not complete. It will take exposing the plans of the enemy. This is an undoing of his added falsehoods we have swallowed. (John 8:44)

18) Finally, and most importantly. The mishandling of the word of God has been repeated throughout history. A devised scheme to keep the body of Christ in a state of immaturity. Misinterpreted. Used improperly. Unstudied. A

quick glance in the Word, if it lines up with our church experience, it must be right.

Disallowed and disregarded the list goes on. All that the enemy of God regards as his property. All that he loves to keep secret. Ignorance means darkness in the original Greek. It is only here the enemy can work.

He cannot execute his plans in the fullness of light. Or in the fullness of our education. Which have compatible meanings as well.

Only with the word of God as our source and confirmation in the original Greek language will I drive home my point.

Only with quotes from papa and from His revelation and years of study and unraveling dare I to continue.

He has a need for ignorance to depart from his family. Just as in heaven, there is no ignorance. James 1 For there is no shadow of turning in God. Everyone serves in heaven, in the fullness of His knowledge and wisdom. He desires the same fullness of service for His family here. We have been attacked here, and need to evolve to this.

You may test the spirit, and find me correct, as the fruit will be freedom.

It is the heart of God who knows we can do better. There is so much more He wants to do. If the fruit of what we believe does not agree with ministry and freedom it is not of God. That spirit disagrees with His intentions and His word.

I am presenting what has passed down to us from those preceding who were lazy. They did not linger to understand the word of God in its fullness. Particularly in the area of ministry.

Others have scrutinized the areas of ministry while still under a great lie. This distorts the perspective and consequent actions for the body of Christ.

This first scripture I am presenting is just about the most undefined and misunderstood scripture “EVER”. It has been imposed upon the body of Christ as mandated truth for centuries without its full understanding. We are going to look at this scripture in depth.

We need to know what the word says regarding ministry. We need to know how the enemy has lies implanted in the word based on misinterpretation and blind tradition. This scripture in particular has not been taken apart and understood in the original Greek language. It has suffered much abuse. It has been terribly misconstrued and used by the enemy to formulate a holding tank.

BEGIN HERE

I am presenting one of the most misused and abused scriptures in all of Christendom. It has become so through our lack of understanding of its terms in the original Greek language. I am sure the enemy has enjoyed a tremendous victory here. He has kept the deception going for centuries.

I realize this is a long introduction, and things have been repeated. It cannot be emphasized enough.

Hebrews 13:17.... “Obey them that have the rule over you, and submit yourselves; for they watch for your souls, as they must give account that they may do so with joy, and not with grief; for that is unprofitable for you.”

I am honoring this scripture in the first chapters as it holds the utmost importance.

It has become so abused from the lack of study and understanding. We have not understood its true meaning in the original Greek and how it should be correctly interpreted for us today.

In not doing so the enemy of God has gained a great advantage of deception. The losses have been great.

We are greatly mistaken in our interpretation of this one scripture in particular. As a result we have not obtained the true benefit of it.

The origin of each word is of most importance. This will be an exacting study of each and every word. It will require your dedicated attention.

Hang on- it is on the way.

QUOTES to start

My best understanding comes from direct quotes from Papa on this topic. How wonderful to know the love of the Father.

His quotes regarding this one scripture- what we are about to study

- 1) Our idea of church and ministry is currently “ based on a few scriptures “
- 2) “They are pouring these 2 scriptures down the throats of the sheep while disregarding Ephesians 4”
- 3) “Heb 13:7- “this one scripture has been read in a distorted form apart from the original Greek and has created generations of ONLOOKERS”

Here is the first scripture we are taking a hard look at.

I am presenting those” few” scriptures that have immobilized the body of Christ in depth. The contradiction begins to unravel.

SO IMPORTANT- this one statement

Hebrews - Realize the entire book of Hebrews in the NEW testament was written to translate us from the old covenant to the new. The changes are described in detail.

I call this the *slingshot* scripture that the enemy has confounded the body of Christ with. To lead us back into the OLD covenant.

Easy Reference Scripture

Hebrews 13:17

Obey them that have the rule over you and submit yourselves. For they watch over your souls and must give account. That they may do it with joy and not with grief for that is unprofitable for you.

For the average Christian, this scripture is familiar. It describes the church service. It all seems to make sense. We file and march into church to be a quiet submitted observer. They are the ones in authority over us. The pastor serves us the word and music which we pay them for.

Catholic church. Which predates bible translation. We think we are done with being catholic but we are still practicing it. Really all we did was upgrade the pew from hardwood to cushion. Then we threw out the candles. Hurray we are free from all that falseness ! NO ! We are still in it. Even after Luther we still kept the same format. It dies hard. It does not want to leave. Like the resurgence of any spirit, it simply takes another form and claims to be gone.

The word kept in Latin had a trickle down effect of ignorance. Authority, quiet, money. March in. under authority. This scripture must be correct. Those over us, the priest, the pastor will have to give an account. They will answer to God on how they taught and ruled us.

They “have the rule” “obey” them, “submit”, this makes it easier on them, they won’t be grieved, they will have to give account for us to God. This is our false interpretation of that scripture that has lasted for 17 centuries.

We are going to dive into the original language of the New Testament, the Greek. The truth. I will be reinserting the scripture before each term for ease of study. So you can refer to it and take your time to understand. The word we will be studying will be in capital letters.

Easy Reference Scripture

Hebrews 13:17..... “Obey them that have the rule over you; and submit yourselves. For they watch for your souls as they must give account. That they may do it with joy and not with grief. For that is unprofitable for you.”

OBEY (the first word to study- others will follow in consecutive order of Heb 13:17

1)The word “ obey” in the original Greek is “peithesthe” which means to listen to.

We have mistakenly interpreted that word ”obey” to mean a military or submissive obedience. It simply means “to listen to”

We have too readily combined the word obey in two different forms. In doing so, we have combined two kingdoms.

Also that word “obey” in the Greek suggests a type of volunteering, a yielding, or being persuaded. Implying to trust or having confidence in someone. It is not a military command.

The other type of meaning for obey is military. Used in the new testament once. The centurion. We will take a look at him a bit later.

We know this type of obedience is not what Jesus meant for His body as He stated and proved in Luke 22:25

Easy Reference Scripture

Hebrews 13:17..... “Obey them that have the rule over you; and submit yourselves. For they watch for your souls as they must give account. That they may do so with joy and not with grief. For that is unprofitable for you.”

THEM THAT HAVE THE RULE

Generations of Christians have interpreted this word rule as a strict imposing right that church leaders have over the sheep. This widely accepted interpretation has sent apostleship and ministry gifts into a death spiral.

“Them that have the rule over you” The accepted interpretation of this phrase is that a pastor has rulership over the sheep. King James 500 years translated this protestant meaning following authority of bishops from those king James appointed as rulers. It rings the bell

of church service. To be silent under a pastor is more of a rule than our own government expects. It is a sound bite. Our lord never demanded such an audience.

2) Here is the truth. The phrase “ them that have the rule over you” in the original Greek is HEGIOMAI”(Hayg-eh-om- ahee) Which means TO SERVE.

Jesus specifically and clearly defines this same Greek word, Hegeomai, as someone who serves, and does NOT exercise authority over others, among Christians.....

“And he said unto them, The kings of the Gentiles exercise lordship over them; and they that exercise authority upon them are called benefactors. But ye shall not be so: but he that is greatest among you, let him be as the younger; and he that is chief, (hegomai) as he that doth serve.” (Luke 22:25-26)

Hegeomai simply means -

TO SERVE. This is actually saying listen to those who are serving you the word of God. It does not say listen to a pastor who is in authority. It does not imply in any way the word must come from a pastor. It does not imply a title of ministry over us. Serving the word to the unsaved. Listen to that person. It is valuable and needed to listen to the word of God. However, this type of service

is to serve without human authority. Ministry means service, not rulership. God is meant to have all authority folks!

The perfect example of this kind of leadership is Jesus himself.

Who said “ I am among you as one who serves” (Luke 22:27). His example of service was to lay down His life. He did not intend after that example for us to take up arms in a military stance of authority over one another.

Easy Reference Scripture

Heb 13:17 “Obey them that have the rule over you; and submit yourselves, for they watch for your souls as they that must give account, that they must do so with joy and not grief.”

SUBMIT means to cooperate as equals.

This word submit in context and in the original Greek is
(hupo+akouo)

Which means to listen attentively, and then respond. It describes a genuine trust based listening from the heart, not a forced conformity.

Another Greek word for this kind of submission is (hypeiko) the root of that word is (eiko) which means to yield or give way to. A voluntary act of deference, not a coerced military command.

Jesus has defined (chief) as someone who serves without authority in his kingdom. It is this aspect of our Christianity we have missed.

Jesus' easy way of submission here means simply to listen. In brotherly cooperation. Bearing one another's burdens.

The very best example of loving submission is Christ himself. He willingly" listened" to the father and became our ransom for sin. He volunteered in love to redeem us. Asking only for love in return. He asks that we love Him as He has loved us. The motivation is richer and deeper than a military command. There is more intelligence in it. More of a relationship- more love. This is our covenant. It is never a military command. It is our choice. Our free will.

He asks no less of us concerning our relationship with one another. He requires no more of us than to be equals and serve Him in this incorrupt way. The corruption of the world cannot enter here. It will, however, enter through our acceptance of over, under, and not beside. This is why our Lord warned us against the use of authority among ourselves. Luke 22:25-26

Submit a big church word. It has been used for centuries to keep the shop open and the sheep in their pen.

"Submit" in the original Greek has 2 types of meaning and usage.

1) One is a military term and it means to submit to the commands of a leader.

The word submit in a military formation is (stratitikos) it is an adjective with the root word as (stere). It is related to (stratos) which is a greek word (encamped army or army)

We are in a spiritual war, and our weapons are not carnal. We are meant to all have authority over Satan, and authority to preach the Gospel, and authority to pray for healing and deliverance, in the name of Jesus.

There is NO instance in the new testament that the word submit is used in the military sense of the word, when used among Christians. I am including the Centurion (a roman soldier high in rank) in this section as it has been an abused scripture.

This scripture has been used to defend church authority in ages past and presently. Luke 22 confounds this and the correct interpretation of the Centurion puts it at rest.

Authority been misconstrued and misunderstood from this scripture it has been used to say “ that centurion really understood authority and we are under a pastor the same way his soldiers were under him”

Matthew 8:5 ask THE CENTURION

“And when Jesus entered into Capernaum, there came unto Him a Centurion beseeching Him (asking for help, prayer, healing)

And saying Lord my servant layeth at home sick of the palsy, and grievously tormented.

And Jesus said unto him, I will come and heal him

The centurion answered Him and said Lord, I am not worthy that thou should come under my roof; but speak the word only and my servant shall be healed.

For I am a man under authority: having soldiers under me; and I say to this man, Go, and he goeth; and to another come; and He cometh and to my servant do this and he doeth it.

When Jesus heard this He marveled and said; “Verily, I say unto you, I have not found so great a faith, not in all of Israel.”

Jesus was impressed with the faith of the Centurion. He recognized the authority Jesus has over sickness, death and devils. So much so he believes Jesus would heal his friend on the spot. The centurion understood his own authority to point at one servant or another to go and do this or that and it would be done. He relates that to Jesus' power and says I know you can do that and you have power over sickness because you are God. They will obey you and my friend will be healed.

This scripture rings the bell of church- as we are in the roman system. We somehow believe this scripture is saying we need to exercise authority over each other- or that it gives us permission to. It makes us think we are under the authority of rule. It is actually an example of our authority in Christ to our authority to cast out devils, heal the sick and preach the gospel.

The centurion who said I am a man of authority, describing exactly how the Roman government worked, one over another. He was describing the military and hierarchial formation of world systems. This world. What we currently practice in church. He related his authority over servants to having faith in Jesus and he understood His power. He

believed in the authority Jesus had over sickness and the devil. His friend was healed. He set aside his military command and responded to Jesus as a person who needed a savior.

As Christians we need to know that we have authority over sickness in the name of Jesus! But as Christians we are told specifically, (3 times in the Gospels, Matthew 20:25-28, Mark 10:42-45, Luke 22:25-29), do not exercise authority one over another among ourselves. What made Jesus say this? He knows we change kingdoms when we do this. We become something from another's rule and we are no longer under His rule.

Jesus said Christians are not of this world system who use authority over one another. We are not them. Luke 22:25-26

The lesson is clear, we have authority over the world, the flesh and the devil. We are called to the sick to heal, to preach or to speak to the lost. "Preach" is another misconstrued word. It means to speak. We have attached to it a podium, authority and the collection of money.

The Centurion believed in Jesus' authority and Jesus healed his friend. The centurion understood Jesus' authority to heal the sick. The more we come out of human authority the more we can come under His divine authority.

2) In non military terms submit means to cooperate and bear one another's burdens in love. A term of equity and equality is not authority in the military sense. We have mistakenly taken this word "submit" to mean we have authority over one another. Pastor to sheep is readily accepted.

Bearing in mind all that Jesus told us about love; and not exercising authority over each other.

When we look at the results of military command, there are less godly rewards. The action in the kingdom of God is always love, and gives higher yields of salvation, healing, eternal life. It makes more sense that Jesus is not interested in putting us under military command- but rather releasing our ministry that gives him souls.

Easy Reference Scripture

Hebrews 13:17

“Obey them that have the rule over you, and submit yourselves; for they watch for your souls, as them that must give account, that they may do it with joy, and not with grief : for that is unprofitable for you.”

ACCOUNT

2) “Them that must give an account”. The word “account” in the original Greek means “Logos” and in the original Greek that means “the word of God”. It means the written word of God.

Rhema is the utterance of God’s word, a saying, a statement. His quotes throughout this book are His Rhema words.

People apply this to their own experience of the traditional church service. It is believed that to ‘give account’ means our rulers must be accountable to God for us.

Recognize this was talking about sharing the word of God as equals. It simply means listen to those who are serving you the LOGOS or the word of God. Account in this context means “ word of God”. It is not implying the accountability of anyone. It is really saying : “ those who serve you the word of God.”

“Give heed, listen to those giving you the word of God.” A good and important message, but not an affirmation of attendance to a pulpit, or a church service or one person’s authority.

Each of you has a psalm, a doctrine..

How is it then, brethren? when ye come together, every one of you hath a psalm, hath a doctrine, hath a tongue, hath a revelation, hath an interpretation. Let all things be done unto edifying. 1 Cor 14:26

Notice this scripture says how is it then, when ye come together- this is stating how God wants church to flow ! “Every one of you” has a part, a doctrine, a word, a psalm, the gifts go on. Are we obeying Him? Or are we only allowing one person to have a right to speak?

Everyone has the right to speak, let's listen! We have forsaken eons of great teaching. Rhema words, healings simply because we believe in one person's authority over the word of God itself!

Put all these things together and no one has a right to be in authority. It contradicts the love and cooperation we are called to. Only our Lord has that right and He moves in love 100 percent of the time. We cannot assume that strength for ourselves.

There is so much more in the word of God concerning our unity, our cooperation, our oneness than there is concerning one gifts dominance.

IMITATE

Easy Reference Scripture

Heb 13:7

“Remember them which have the rule over you; who have spoken unto you the word of God: whose faith follow, considering the end of their conversation.”

If read correctly, this scripture reveals more of our rights to ministry.

That word conversation in the Greek means lifestyle. In this case his ministry.

Again, that phrase "them which have rule over you" means to serve. Hegiomai. Those who are serving you the word. Anyone teaching you the word of God "remember them" in this easy way.

"Whose faith follow"

Paul is telling us to follow that example- or to imitate their ministry. We are ALL called to serve the word of God to unsaved souls.

"Considering the end of their conversation" That word conversation in the Greek means "lifestyle" or in this case their way of life or ministry, the way they are serving God

Hebrews 13:7

Now we get to the real picture: this scripture is telling us to imitate those who serve us the word ! This is claiming the chief among us are those who serve the word, and we should be like them.

It is not claiming a strict military rule over God's children. It is the opposite and it is actually declaring a release of ministry ! Be as those who are showing you the word of God and do it yourself ! It is not mentioning a title of position but a clear and simple way to complete evangelism or apostleship or teaching with the word of God. It is actually an exhortation to preach the word of God- only qualification is that you are a christian. Preach" in the original greek is simply to speak"

It is not attached to a title, a podium, a pulpit or a tithe.

Let the Lord tell us who we are after we have spoken the word to a needy soul. He will whisper “that was a bit of evangelism you just did” “you are that person’s pastor for a time, they need someone to guide them” “ or “you had a prophetic word just then” “you will see them in heaven”

It is He who leads us with his anointing. We can slip in and out of roles of ministry in a day. How simple. Depending on the need.

I have heard all this from the Lord at different times in my life when He was using me. None of that gave me an official title of service OVER anyone. None of those people would have been helped had I believed myself to be a sheep with no ministry. Nor would they have been helped any more if I believed I had an “office”. Do we see how the release of ministry to the whole body of Christ is a more effective and easier way than placing a title over one person?

Our Lord simply does not move in ordinance, officiation, title or humanistic rule. In fact, He died to set us free from it.

As a child, hidden from the wise. Love works in his kingdom by relationship. In the power of equality. He has given us no less than what he has done. Sacrifice. Cooperation. He has given us a choice. Never a demand to know Him. Likewise He has not charged us over one another. He has demonstrated sacrifice. He has invited us to find the

world that knows him not. To give them the love He has given us. As equals.

Easy Reference Scripture

Hebrews 13:17

Obey them that have the rule over you and submit yourselves,
For they watch for your souls, as they that must give account, that they
may do it with joy and not with grief for that is unprofitable for you.

RULE

The phrase “ them that have the rule over” can be directly related to one word in the Greek.

Hegeomai (hayg-eh'-om-ahee)

In the Greek it means to lead. Jesus' definition, however, in Luke 22 someone who is serving; not using exercising authority.

Luke 22 : 25-26

And He said unto them “ The kings of the Gentiles exercise Lordship over them; and they that exercise authority upon them are called benefactors.

The kings of the Gentiles are the human leaders which included kings, emperors and human authority. Referring here to a godless society of Rome.

They are called benefactors or as those who give benefit to you. Or pay you in some form of education as to the roman soldiers. They exercise human authority. Different than God's authority.

26 But it shall not be so among you; but he that is greatest among you , let him be the servant, and he that is chief- Hegeomai. As he that does serve, *stating that exercising human authority among christians shall not be. Not of His kingdom. Saying the greatest among us is He who serves.*

Chief means to serve; someone leading in the word of god; does not have authority over you but is meant to be unequal

Vs 27 “I am among you as one who serves” not as an authority

Jesus defines Hegeomai specifically as service to others– not authority over” others. As he is the greatest example of.

Luke 22 clearly defines leadership in the world as being the use of authority over one another. He goes on to say “NOT so among you He has something else in mind “Service, without military authority but in love of God. These are 2 different things.

7 remember them which have the rule over you, who have spoken unto you the word of God; whose faith follow, considering the end of their conversation

We are exhorted to follow the faith of any christian who gives us the word of God. nothing about their authority.

CONCISE wrap up

The concise meaning of key words in Hebrews 13:17

1) **Obey** means to listen, to be in agreement with

Not implying a military rule or formation

2) **Them that have the rule** (hegeomai) To serve is (hegiomi) someone who is serving and specifically not exercising authority over others.

Luke 22 is in agreement with (Hegeomai) to serve or chief

3) **Submit** means to cooperate (as equals, brothers) in love.

Not listen up *I got you under me*

4) **Account** means logos or the word of God

Not implying the accountability to a leader or to chart in and make record of progress

Easy Reference Scripture

Obey them that have the rule over you, and submit yourselves, for they watch for yours souls, as them that must give account

Hebrews 13:17

ACCOUNT

The word account in the Greek is “logos” or word of God. This is tricky too. It sounds at first read as if leaders have to give account to God and we should make it easier for them. Under authority as well.

As I stated, “account” in this context in the original Greek means “the word of God”.

So someone is serving you the word, developing your soul, if you listen cooperatively, you will benefit.

This does not mean they own you. Or you give money. Or they have authority over you. It is this part of our doctrine that needs to be laid to rest. It is then we are sucking the corruption out of 1000 or more years of deception.

We need to test the spirit, does this agree with God's spirit?

This one single scripture has been used to create generations of onlookers and non participants in the kingdom of God. *This has been the fruit of this scripture misinterpreted. It also has been abused to keep power throughout history.* It has reigned in the tithe, given titles that are not in the word, and turned apostles, prophets and evangelists into

submitted sheep. It has created a system and type of slavery where we pay for over and over. We never become all God has intended.

These two scriptures should be read together and interchangeably for they expose the greek meaning well and define true leadership

Hebrews 13:17

We have not defined rule the way Jesus did. The greek word for “ have the rule over” is the word “Hegiomai” this is the exact word as “Chief”.

So it is stating whoever serves among you is the greatest.

This has seldom been related to Luke 22:25-26 which says

You know that the kings of the gentiles exercise authority one over another but not so among you- but rather he that is chief shall be as He is who serves- even as I am among you as one who serves.

True leadership is Christ himself, who only came to serve us. He is king of kings and the Chief or greatest as He laid His life down.

CONCLUDING Peeling back the layers- unraveling the puzzle

Also keep in mind it is not a totality of loss. We have hope and a future as the word says. Education must happen first. The kingdom of God is here within us, always has been, and is the authority of God that does His work on the earth. Through all of us. This is the work, in us. Our subject is ministry and the lack of it. Are we truly serving His kingdom, His authority? All the tricks the enemy has successfully employed for centuries are here. I am not eliminating the possibility that you may find more. God is all about releasing ministry and never holding it. This is a good start.

This journal will expose throughout where we have missed it. And why. It is not to say there is no ministry emanating from the body of Christ today. There certainly is -“but it could be so much better” quote from Papa. And there will be many more.

Primarily, our enemy has encouraged laziness of study regarding ministry gifts. We have accepted half truths, buzzwords and isms.

It has not led us to a comprehensive understanding simply to accept things as they are and blindly believe the buzzwords we hear in church.

We are in great need. Without knowing it. We need to study the word of God deeply. This helps the world and our brain. We are created for it and our brain likes the challenge.

We need to realize a purpose for Him can be sought and obtained through the study of ministry. What an adventure !

Having accepted the status quo and never truly giving heed to the word has given the enemy great advantage. This is why he wins.

It is why the body of Christ is wondering why God is not using them.

Or why there are not more healings, salvation. Or why He is only using a few. It is because “the few” is the misconception.

The enemy is looking for a crack and we have given him a large one.

We will travel to places biblically that have not been studied, not been understood, and therefore have not been adhered to. We are going to understand the results of our misunderstanding with completeness.

Indeed, with consequences. We are going to venture into places that have been brutally attacked by the enemy. Places so deeply misconstrued by the enemy of God we can hardly recognize their origins.

We can hardly understand why we believe things because the puzzle has been set.

The argument has been won already. The lazy gospel has been devised and spewed out for centuries. These lies have been swallowed as truth by tradition. Deception has then taken over and adhered to as truth.

When I say lazy, I am implying unstudied. We simply have not taken the time to see the word, and apply it.

Lazy again in our true service as consequently we do very little ministry.

We have grossly underestimated what the Lord wants to do. What He can do among us. Jesus challenges us to meet the world with His word and His love. He will not leave us upon trying and during our attempts.

In fact, He will run to us with great love and every provision. Moving

into the supernatural that the routine of church denies us. There is so much more to be done

A conversation with the enemy and his cohorts is never an obvious one, an honest one or an easy one. They are all prolific and experienced liars. If their lips are moving they are lying. The trick is to discern who is talking. Through understanding and study and over time we can. The Lord has revealed the enemy's code. Indeed, found out his code and forever exposed it. If understanding comes, it will break the downward cycle of abuse. His arguments and deception will cease.

My biblically based findings have been covered for centuries.

INHERIT the promises of ministry

Covered with lies, falsehoods, arguments that are non biblical in nature but still persuasive. These lies are covered by the word itself that works from a distorted interpretation. It is no doubt that these false impressions pass as truth from one generation to another.

These lies are ancient. Cleverly crafted by the highest order of intelligent demons to mask the truth. He has attacked the ministry gifts. He has delayed their true effectiveness and function for centuries. He is a raging success in this realm. They are congratulating each other in hell. My hope is that the exposure I have given will lessen his effectiveness for us and the following generations. It is my godly gift and purpose to

understand this. Your understanding will release your godly gifts and ministry and that without training, education, officialness or ordinations of man. Simply by the spirit of God as He has intended. God knows exactly who you are and you need not sign the registrar. You will become a free child of God hearing from the Lord more deeply because you have been released from tradition, the lies of the enemy and a false identity. He will gladly give to anyone their personal significance and destiny in Christ. This is the miracle He is waiting to give. You will know what it means to truly be free in Christ and to serve Him as you were created to. Life itself will make sense and hold greater meaning in the arms of a loving God who needs you !

A shared cooperation is a clear and unmistakable sign of God's kingdom service is a new testament function- not authority. Jesus said He has no part of us unless He could wash our feet. He unmistakably shuttles us off into another kingdom with the example of the washing of feet. It is the opposite of authority. With which if we exercise, shuttles us back into the roman gerbil cage which serves no purpose.

He was showing us the kingdom of God is not a platform, It is actually a stepping down. It is this stepping down, and out of this world's devices that truly releases His power.

Think of Jesus on the cross. Suffocating. Naked. Pierced. Flogged.

Not an example of authority, pride and platform. Our example of stepping out of this world and defeating the enemy forever on our behalf.

Conclude

If we are reading “Hegeomai” without the original Greek there is a great gap. If we have missed Jesus’ definition of this Greek word we have missed a lot! This is what I knew to be wrong. I am glad that I was intelligent enough to hear, strong enough to continue, diligent enough to unravel, (the discrepancy), and caring enough to destroy the lie for you. This has been God in me, doing the work. Using a few of my gifts- but it has been Him.
