But let us pretend, for the sake of our story, that the two men were right and they were to be judged by their good works...

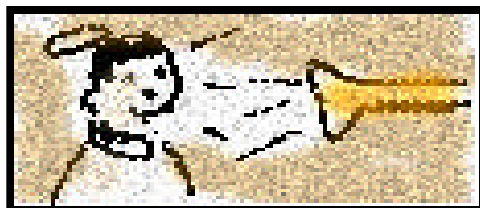


So the two men died, on the very same day--and to the presence of the Lord in heaven they went... “absent from the body,... present with the Lord.” (2 Cor. 5:8,).
