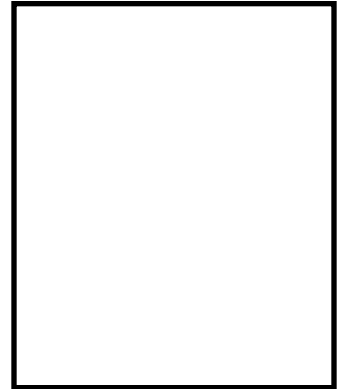
(By the way, after you’ve been saved, your good works will then be offered unto God. You see, God does want you to “be good”, but He wants you to be good for Him--!)

Today is the day to realize that you are a sinner and don’t deserve to be with God in heaven. Because in that moment of repentance, Jesus will forgive you.

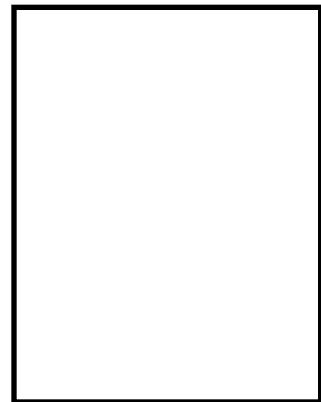
He will wash you in His blood and forgive all your sin- and He will write your name in the Book of Life!
