....for He was rejected also. His name is Jesus Christ, and He can help you.

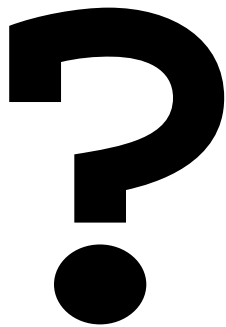
Imagine, He created the world...

"...that whosoever believeth in him shall not perish, but have everlasting life." (John 3:16).

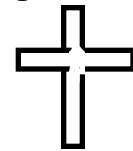
What Jesus asks most of us is to "believe."
