..And stole the keys of Hell and death!!


"I am he that liveth, and was dead; and, behold, I am alive for evermore, Amen; and have the keys of hell and of death. (Revelation 1:18, KJV).

No longer did Satan own the souls of everyone on earth! No longer could death claim victory over every soul! Now, Jesus had created a way for anyone to be saved!




The Bible, God's holy word, says.....
