

Part 2 (the faith part)

"In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins." [Ephesians 1:7] Your sin can be forgiven! God requires a blood sacrifice in order to forgive your sin. Jesus Christ has done this for you!

"Whom God set forth to be a propitiation by His blood, through faith... God has passed over the sins that were previously committed." [Romans 4:25] By faith believe that Jesus died for you!

"for God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him, should not perish but have everlasting life" [John 3:16]

Part 3 (the glorious part)

"For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord." [Romans 6:23]

Have you acknowledged your sin to Jesus, and believed through faith that His blood has washed away your sin? Guess what!? God has a free gift for you--

"that if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raise Him from the dead, you will be saved. For with the heart one believes unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation."

[Romans 10:9-10]

You see in a few moments of sincere prayer--you can be saved!

Say this simple prayer:

Lord Jesus, you are almighty God. I want you to be Lord of my life. I am a sinner. I am not righteous and fall short of your great glory. But I believe that you have paid the price for my sin. Your death on the cross, the shedding of your precious blood **washes away my sin.** I want you to be my Savior, my Lord, my friend. Come into my heart now, Lord Jesus, set me free from the prison of my sin. And because I believe in you Jesus, I "shall not die, but have everlasting life,"

Thank you Jesus!

And now that you are saved--go tell everyone you meet that Jesus is Lord!

CUT--HERE

and verse 4:10 says...

"In this is love, not that we loved God, but that He loved us and sent His Son to be the propitiation for our sins."

Let's just put it all together in context and get ALL the message...." **...God is love..In this the love of God was manifested toward us, that God has sent His only begotten Son into the world, that we might live through Him. In this is love, not that we loved God, but that He loved us and sent His Son to be the propitiation for our sins."** (1John 4:8-10)

This is how God has expressed His love for us! He sent His Son, Jesus Christ, to die for us, to forgive our sin! Jesus became a man, went up on the cross and became sin--to be the sacrifice for sin--**for your sin!!** --this is how we can receive the gift of eternal life. By confessing our sin to Jesus--being washed in His blood--this is how God loves us!

"that if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raise Him from the dead, you will be saved." [Romans 10:9]

Say this simple prayer:
