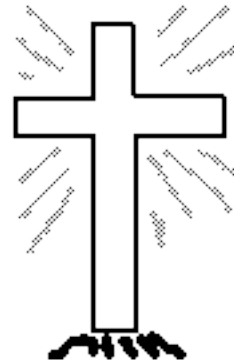
The Truth=Jesus
