keep.



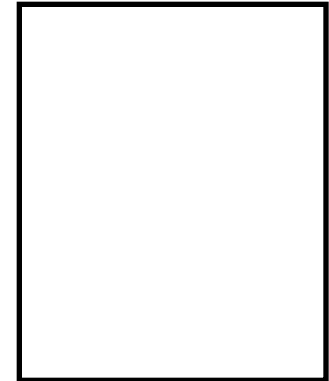
And finally, after death, there is a

yourself, because Jesus loves you!!

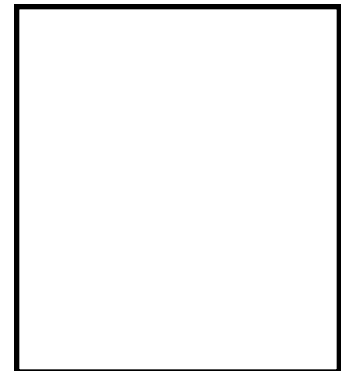
