6 And ye shall hear of wars and rumors of wars: see that ye be not troubled: for all these things must come to pass, but the end is not yet. 7 For nation shall rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom: and there shall be famines, and pestilences, and earthquakes, in divers' places.

Today's major news headlines are about countries fighting against each other militarily, such as invasions of sovereign states as seen in Russia, the invasion of Ukraine, middle east turmoil, with Yemen and Saudi Arabia, a standoff in Iran with the United States and her neighbors. Economically, there are trade wars between the US and China and socially through cyber warfare, social media and others involving the US, Russia and China. Natural disasters, such as earthquakes of high magnitude on the richter scale, as well as flooding unlike anything we've seen in our lifetime. We are seeing very destructive tornadoes and volcanoes that are claiming many lives and properties in an instant, these events are on the rise and occurring at regular frequencies. Some have swiftly come to the conclusion that the past has not been great, the present seems awful and the future looks very bleak!

9 Then shall they deliver you up to be afflicted and shall kill you: and ye shall be hated of all nations for my name's sake. 10 And then shall many be offended, and shall betray one another, and shall hate one another

Look around you today, there is so much evil. Love or loving your neighbor is no longer a widespread societal norm, being your neighbor's keeper is seen as selling out. Young kids and teenagers have become unruly and disobedient to their parents; daughters in-law fighting against mothers in-law, homicide, suicide and divorce rates on astronomical rise. 11 And many false prophets shall rise and shall deceive many. 12 And because iniquity shall abound, the love of many shall wax cold.

Consequently tithes and donations overwhelm the preaching of the Gospel and the brotherhood of equity described in the new testament. Some outrightly ascribing to themselves the labels exclusively reserved for Jesus, the son of the most high God, such as Christ, Savior and Messiah. Love for wealth acquisition has replaced Godly aspirations and pursuits in the heart of many today.

21 "For then shall be great tribulation, such as was not since the beginning of the world to this time, no, nor ever shall be. 22 And except those days should be shortened, there should no flesh be saved: but for the elect's sake those days shall be shortened."

If you think things are bad now, just imagine what it will be like when the whole world would be subject to the wrath of God! At the end-times God will unleash punishments of unimaginable magnitude on mankind both here on earth during the great tribulation, and in the life to come in eternity, for rejecting His only begotten son Jesus Christ.

29 "Immediately after the tribulation of those days shall the sun be darkened, and the moon shall not give her light, and the stars shall fall from heaven, and the powers of the heavens shall be shaken"
