

Bible Verses to Combat Fear



These verses will bring Comfort and increase your Faith. I suggest that you pick out a verse or two of these for each day and read, or say them often; and if you keep doing it, after awhile you will know them, but it's good to go back and read them in the Bible sometimes, also. **Speak to the mountain, and don't let the mountain speak to you!** Let me first share these verses with you in Proverbs 4:20- 23: "My son, (or daughter) attend to My words; incline thine ear unto My sayings." "Let them not depart from thine eyes; keep them in the midst of thine heart." 22 For they are life unto those that find them, and Health to all their flesh." Keep thy heart with all diligence; for out of it are the issues (curative medicine) of life." "A Merry Heart doeth good like a medicine:" Ps. 17:21

Now some verses: "Thou wilt keep him in perfect Peace whose mind is stayed on thee: because he trusteth in thee." "Trust ye in the Lord for ever: for in the Lord Jehovah is Everlasting Strength!" Is. 26:3-4 "Fear thou not; For I am with thee: be not dismayed; for I am thy God: I will strengthen thee; Yea, I will help thee; Yea, I will uphold thee with the right hand of My righteousness." Is. 41:10 "Fear not: for I have redeemed thee, I have called thee by thy name; thou art Mine." "When thou passest through the waters, I will be with thee; and through the rivers, they shall not overflow thee: when thou walkest through the fire, thou shalt not be burned; neither shall the flame kindle upon (scorch) thee." "For I am the Lord thy God, the Holy One of Israel, thy Saviour." Is. 43:1-3 "Trust in the Lord with all thine heart, and lean not unto thine own understanding." In all thy ways acknowledge Him, and He shall direct thy paths." Pr. 3:5-6 "When thou liest down, thou shalt not be afraid: yea, thou shalt lie down, and thy sleep shall be sweet." Be not afraid of sudden fear, neither of the desolation of the wicked, when it cometh." "For the Lord shall be thy confidence, and shall keep thy foot from being taken." Pr. 3:24-26

"But whoso hearkeneth unto Me shall dwell safely, and shall be quiet from fear of evil. Pr. 1:33 "What time I am afraid, I will Trust in Thee." Ps. 56:3 "Peace I leave with you, My Peace I give unto you: not as the world giveth, give I unto you." "Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid." John 14:27 "If thou can believe, all things are possible to him that believeth." Mk. 9:23 "Ask, and it shall be given you, Seek, and ye shall find, Knock, and it shall be opened unto you: For every one that Asketh receiveth; and he that Seeketh findeth; and to him that Knocketh it shall be opened." "Or what man is there of you, whom if his son ask bread, will he give him a Stone?" "Or if he ask a fish, will he give him a serpent?" "If ye then, being evil, know how to give good gift unto your children, How Much More shall your Father which is in Heaven give Good things to them that Ask Him?" Matt. 7-11

“Have Faith in God.” “For whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; He shall have whatsoever he saith. “Therefore, I say unto you, What things soever you desire, when you pray, believe that you receive them, and you shall have them.” “And when you stand praying, forgive, if you have anything against anyone: that your Father also which is in Heaven may forgive your trespasses.” Mk 23:22-25 “Confess your faults one to another, and pray one for another, that ye may be healed.” The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man availeth much.” James 5:16 “But I say unto you, Love your enemies, bless them that curse you, do good to them that hate you, and pray for them which despitefully use you, and persecute you;” Matt. 5:44 “Delight thyself in the Lord, and He shall give thee the desires of thine heart.” “Commit thy way unto the Lord, Trust also in Him; and He shall bring it to pass.” “And He shall bring forth thy righteousness as the light, and thy judgment as the noonday.” “Rest in the Lord and wait Patiently for Him.”

The Lord is the strength of my life; of whom shall I be afraid.” Ps. 27:1 “Be of good Courage, and He shall strengthen thine heart, all ye that Hope in the Lord.” Ps. 31:24 “Many sorrows shall be to the wicked: but he that Trusteth in the Lord, Mercy shall compass him about.” Ps. 32:10 “No weapon that is formed against thee shall prosper;” Is. 55:17 “When the enemy shall come in like a flood, the Spirit of the Lord shall life up a standard against him.” Is. 59:20 “So shall My Word be that goeth forth out of My mouth: It shall not return unto Me Void: but it shall accomplish that which I please, and it shall prosper in the thing whereto I sent it.” “For ye shall go out with Joy, and be led forth with Peace: the mountains and the hills shall break forth before you with singing, and all the trees of the field shall clap their hands!” Is. 55:11 “If ye abide in Me, and My Words abide in you, ye shall ask what ye will, and it shall be done unto you.” Jn 15:7 “And this is the Confidence that we have in Him, that, if we ask any thing according to His Will, He heareth us: And if we know that He hear us, whatsoever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we desire of Him.” 1 Jn 5:14-15
