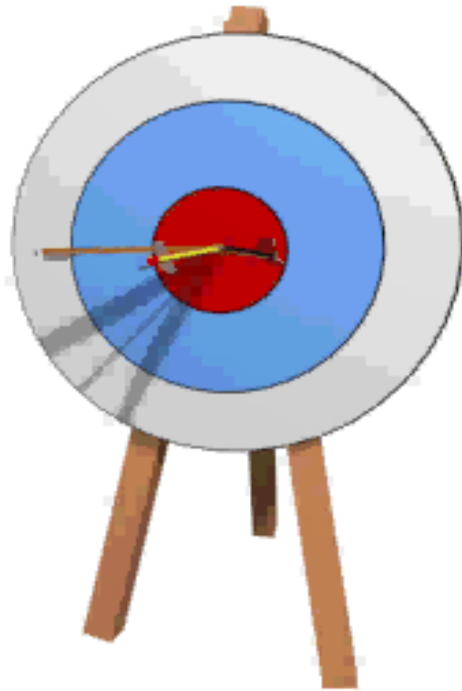


LET'S GET TO THE POINT!



YESHUA IS MESSIAH!

From the beginning, the Tenach (Jewish Bible) promised a Messiah (Genesis 3:15), a Savior for both Jews and Gentiles (Isaiah 49:6). The *Tenach* reveals over 65 distinctives of the Messiah. He would be from the tribe of Judah (Micah 5:2), a descendant from the family of David (Jeremiah 23:5-6), and born of a virgin (Isaiah 7:14) in Bethlehem (Micah 5:2,4) The specific time the Messiah would be cut off (Daniel 9:26). His triumphal entry into Jerusalem fulfilled the prophecy in Zechariah 9:9. He would be betrayed by a friend (Psalm 41:9) and sold for 30 pieces of silver (Zechariah 11:13). In Isaiah 53, we read about the details of Yeshua's sufferings. He would be wounded for our sins and transgressions, his hands and feet would be pierced. He would suffer and die (Isaiah 53:9) as an atoning sacrifice prior to the destruction of the Temple by the Romans in 70 CE (AD) (Daniel 9:24-26). Not a single bone would be broken (Psalm 34:20). He would be resurrected (Psalm 16:10).

Yeshua-Jesus, was from the tribe of Judah (Luke 3:33), the family of David (Luke 3:31) and born of a virgin in Bethlehem (Matthew 1:18-23, 2:1). He was betrayed by a friend (John 18:5, Mark 14:17-18) and sold for 30 pieces of silver (Matthew 26:15). He did suffer and die (Matthew 27:33-56) as an atoning sacrifice prior to the destruction of the Temple in 70 CE (AD). Not a single bone of Yeshua was broken during His scourging, the crucifixion itself, nor by the Roman soldiers who broke the other victim's legs (John 19:36). He was resurrected providing salvation for Jew and Gentile (Matthew 28:1-20). From the Brit-Chadashah, the New Covenant.

The Hebrew Bible says that man's sin separates him from a perfect and Holy God.

Isaiah 59:2: But your iniquities have separated you from your God; And your sins have Hidden *His* face from you, so that He will not hear. **Ecclesiastes 7:20:** For there is not a just man upon earth, that does good, and sins not. **Ezekiel 18:4:** The soul who sins will die (spiritually).

The Hebrew Bible says that God requires blood sacrifice for the atonement of sin.

Leviticus 17:11: For the life of the flesh is in the blood, and I have given it to you on the altar to make atonement for your souls; for it is the blood that makes atonement for the soul.

Messiah Yeshua suffered and died as the final blood sacrifice for the forgiveness of sin. He was buried and resurrected providing salvation for both Jews and Gentiles who accept His final atoning sacrifice for the forgiveness of their sins. (1Corinthians 15:1-4), (New Covenant). **John 3:16:** For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believes in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.
