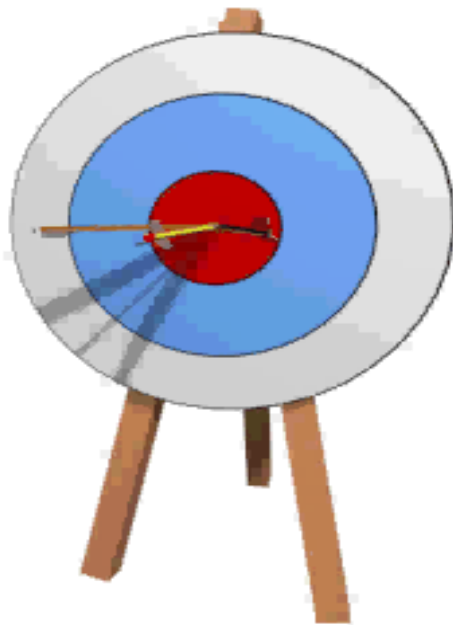


LET'S GET TO THE POINT!



Jesus Is Messiah!

From the beginning, the Holy Bible promised a Messiah (Genesis 3:15), a Savior for the world. The Holy Bible revealed the exact distinctives of the Messiah and Jesus Christ fulfilled them all. **Jesus Christ** was from the tribe of Judah (Luke 3:33), the family of David (Luke 3:31) and born of a virgin in Bethlehem (Matthew 1:18-23, 2:1). He was betrayed by a friend (John 18:5, Mark 14:17-18) and sold for 30 pieces of silver (Matthew 26:15). He did suffer and die (Matthew 27:33-56) as an atoning sacrifice prior to the destruction of the Temple in 70 CE (AD). Not a single bone of Jesus was broken during His scourging, the crucifixion itself, nor by the Roman soldiers who broke the other victim's legs (John 19:36). He was resurrected providing salvation for Jew and Gentile (Matthew 28:1-20).

Man experiences separation between himself and God because of sin.

For *there is* not a just man on earth who does good and does not sin (Ecclesiastes 7:20). The soul who sins will die (Ezekiel 18:4). ...and it is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgment: (Hebrews 9:27).

The Holy Bible says that God requires blood sacrifice for the atonement of sin.

Leviticus 17:11: For the life of the flesh is in the blood, and I have given it to you on the altar to make atonement for your souls; for it is the blood that makes atonement for the soul.

God sent the Messiah, Jesus Christ his Son, to provide that atonement.

1 John 1:7 ...and the blood of Jesus Christ his Son cleanses us from all sin. **John 1:29:** "Behold the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world! **Romans 5:9:** ⁹ ... being now justified by his blood, we shall be saved from wrath through him. **1 Corinthians 15:3-4:** ¹ I declare unto you the gospel... ...how that Christ died for our sins according to the scriptures; ⁴ and that he was buried, and that he rose again the third day... **Romans 6:23:** For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.

Salvation by Faith

John 3:16: For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believes in him should not perish, but have everlasting life. **John 3:36:** He who believes in the Son has eternal life; but he who does not obey the Son shall not see life, but the wrath of God abides on him.

The moment you believe in Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins, God counts your faith as righteousness and gives you the gift of eternal life and peace with God. Blessings
