

Confidence Builders In God's Word



In order to receive from God, we need to have Faith in Him and His Word.

You can personalize them, too, like putting in "I" or "My" or "Me", etc. Or, read them right from your Bible often, have the ones you are focusing on written down in a notebook; or a combination, and do all 3.)

"My God shall supply All my Need according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus." Phil. 4:19 "Nay, in all these things, we am More than a Conqueror thru Christ who loves us." Romans 8:28 "I can do all things through Christ which strengthens me." Phil. 4:13 "Cast not away therefore your confidence which hath great recompence of Reward; for you have need of Patience, that, after you have done the will of God you will receive the Promise."
