"But God introduced His love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us. Much more then, being now justified by His blood, we shall be saved from wrath through Him." Romans 5:8-9"

"But we are all as an unclean thing, and all our righteousnesses are as filthy rags; and we all do fade as a leaf; and our iniquities, like the wind have taken us away. And known that we can't earn our way to Heaven by being good or doing good deeds...only by the shed blood of Jesus.

We are justified freely by His grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus; Whom God hath set forth to be the propitiation through FAITH in His blood, to declare His righteousness for the remission of sins that are past, through the forbearance of God." Romans 3:24,25

Isaiah 1:18: "Come now, and let us reason together, saith the Lord: though your sins be as scarlet, they shall be as white as snow; though they be red like crimson, they shall be as wool."

"If ye be willing and obedient, ye shall eat the good of the land: But if ye refuse and rebel ye shall be devoured with the sword: for the mouth of the Lord hath spoken it."

"Therefore being justified by Faith, we have Peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ." Romans 5:1, and further he could have read:

"But what saith it? The Word is nigh thee, even in thy mouth, and in thy heart: that is, the Word of faith, which we preach:"

"That if thou shalt confess with thy Mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt Believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved." Romans 10:8,9

Jesus said that you must be born again in John 3:3-8

"Truly, Truly, I say unto thee, Except a man be born again (regenerated, conceived) from Above, he cannot see the Kingdom of God. (Join the Family of God) V 3

And again He said, Truly, Truly, I say unto thee, Except a man be born of water and of the Spirit, he cannot enter into the Kingdom of God." (be a part of the Family of Jesus) V 5

"That which is born of the flesh is flesh; (human nature, carnally minded) and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit." (Christ's Spirit) V 6

"Marvel not that I said unto thee, Ye must be born again." V 7

"The wind bloweth where it pleases and thou hearest the sound thereof, but canst not tell whence it cometh and whither it goeth; so is every one that is born (conceived, regenerated) of the Spirit." (represents a change) V 8

"That whosoever believeth (has faith, and commits and entrusts his spiritual well being to Christ) shall not perish, but have Everlasting Life." V 15

"For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever Believeth in Him should not perish but have Everlasting Life."

V 16

"For God sent not His Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through Him might be saved." V 17

"He that Believeth on Him is not condemned: but he that believeth not is condemned already, because he hath not believed in the Name of the only begotten Son of God." V 18

If this man wouldn't have had the chance to see himself in the mirror called the Holy Bible he wouldn't have known the way of redemption and Eternal Life.

We all have to say the Sinner's Prayer and be Born Again like this:

Dear Lord Jesus,

I believe that you died on the Cross for my sins. Lord, I'm a Sinner and I sincerely, and humbly, come to you for forgiveness.

Please come into my heart and let there be a change in my heart so that I am Born Again from Above.
