Faith can be like that. The first step is to say you are sorry for your sins, and ask for forgiveness, and ask Jesus to change your heart and receive Jesus in prayer.

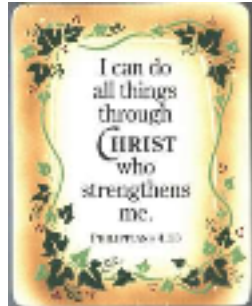
