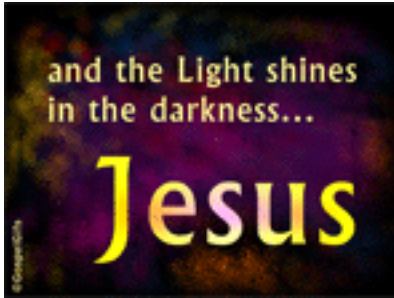


FINDING THE ONE TRUE GOD



There is someone whose Name is JESUS! He is the one True God! Not Mohammed or anyone else. And there aren't many God's to worship like the Hindus believe in. They are devils that they are worshipping and they want to destroy you!

Mohammed was a human being, and like everyone else he died. Jesus died and rose again from the dead! He is ALIVE!

His Holy Spirit moved on Holy men of God to write the only true Bible to live by.

“Knowing this first, that no prophecy of the Scripture is of any private interpretation.”

“For the prophecy came not in Old time by the will of man: but Holy men of God spake as they were moved (and wrote it down) by the Holy Ghost.” 2 Peter 1:20, 21

You will find all about Jesus in the pages of the Bible. He was not just a Prophet or a good man. He was God manifest in the flesh! He made himself a body to come down to earth to shed His blood for our sins.

“And without controversy, great is the mystery of godliness: God was manifest in the flesh, justified in the Spirit, seen of angels, preached unto the Gentiles, believed on in the world, received up into glory.” 1 Timothy 3:16

“In Whom we have redemption through His Blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of His grace.” Ephesians 1:7

Man is born sinful and we can't be saved and go to Heaven without the redeeming blood of Jesus Christ.

“Behold, I was shapen in iniquity; and in sin did my mother conceive me.” Psalm 51:5

All roads don't lead to Heaven! There is only one right Way! Or we will be sent to hell for Eternity. We have to make Jesus our Saviour, surrender our lives to Him and learn His Ways by studying and obeying the Bible if we want to go to Heaven.

Being good or doing good deeds won't save us! “But we are all as an unclean thing, and all our righteousness are as filthy rags. Isaiah 64:6

We have to choose which way we will go. We can receive God's pardon for our sins by repenting or we can reject it as something we aren't interested in or just refuse to believe that we need it.

The Bible says that we must be born again. John 3:3 “Truly, Truly, I say unto thee, Except a man be born again (regenerated, conceived) he cannot see the kingdom of God.”

Verse 3:5 Jesus answered Nicodemus, “Truly, Truly, I say unto thee, Except a man be born of water and of the Spirit, he cannot enter into the Kingdom of God.”

“That which is born of the flesh (human nature with it's frailities, moral and physical) is flesh and that which is born of the Spirit (Christ's Spirit, the Holy Spirit) is spirit.”

“The wind bloweth where it listeth (pleases) and thou hearest the sound thereof, but canst not tell whence it cometh, and whither it goeth: so is everyone that is born (regenerated, conceived) of the Spirit.” A change are the results of the wind. John 3:6, 8

That whosoever believeth in Him (has faith, commits himself, entrusts his well being to Christ) should not perish but have Eternal life.” John 3:15

“For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in Him should not perish, but have everlasting Life.”

“For God sent not His Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through Him might be saved.”

John 3:16, 17

This is what we do: We confess with our mouth the Lord Jesus believing in our heart that God has raised Him from the dead. Because the Bible says with the heart man believeth (entrusts one's spiritual well being to Christ) unto righteousness and with the mouth confession is made unto Salvation. Confession means acknowledgement of the Truth.

Romans 10:9, 10

“For whosoever shall call on the Name of the Lord shall be saved.” Romans 10:13

Acts 2:38, 39 says, Repent, and be baptized in the Name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost. (Holy Spirit)

“For the promise (of the Holy Ghost) is unto you, and to your children, and to all that are afar off, (everyone who wants it) even as many as the Lord our God shall call.”

When we have repented and confessed our sins; we need to be baptized by immersion in Jesus Name. Then we get the privilege of receiving the gift of the Holy Ghost. (Holy Spirit) Sometimes people who are worshipping Jesus receive it before they are baptized.

Here is a sinner's prayer that you can pray:

Lord Jesus, have mercy on me, a Sinner. I believe in You and that your Word is true.

I believe that You are the Son of the Living God and that You died on the Cross so that I may now have forgiveness for my sins and Eternal Life.

Please Lord Jesus forgive me and come into my heart as my personal Lord and Saviour today.

I need you to be my Father and Friend. I give you my life, and ask you to take full control from this moment!

I pray this in Jesus Name.

Amen.

When you have done this you are ready to receive the Holy Spirit. Just start praying that Jesus will come and fill you with His wonderful Spirit. Be worshipping Him sincerely and telling Him how much you love Him.

When He feels that you are ready He will come and fill you. It may be right away or it may take some time. It might not happen the same day or even for awhile.

Just keep doing what you are doing, praying and worshipping Him often. Worshipping to worship songs or going to worship in church would help a lot.

When He fills you there may be some words formed in your mind. Even if they sound strange, just speak them out.

When you have received the Holy Spirit keep worshipping Jesus and daily reading your Holy Bible to build you up in the knowledge of God. It is imperative to develop the habit of daily reading your Bible and studying it's various themes so as to be grounded in the things of God. By reading it you will learn about how God thinks concerning any subject you wish to be enlightened on.

Every moral or spiritual doctrine must be firmly backed by the Scriptures because God's Word is the rock on which we stand!

Associate yourself with Christian groups where the Bible is studied to get the necessary help and basic knowledge you need. From the Bible you will learn to obey what it says, rather than what man or human philosophy teaches.
