
JESUS' DEATH

- Jesus Christ foretold the kind of death He was going to die. John 12:33
- Jesus foretold that He would be raised on the third day. Matthew 17:23; 20:17
- While we were helpless, sinners, and enemies, Jesus died for the ungodly.
 Romans 5:6-10
- Jesus died for sins once for all—the just and the unjust—in order to bring us to God. 1 Peter 3:18; Romans 6:10
- By the grace of God Jesus tasted death for everyone. Hebrews 2:9
- Once at the consummation of the ages Jesus put away sin by the sacrifice of Himself. Hebrews 9:26
- **Jesus bore our sins** in His body on the cross, that man might die to sin. 1 Peter 2:24
- Jesus gave Himself for our sins. Galatians 1:4
- Jesus reconciled Jews & Gentiles into one body on the cross. Ephesians 2:16
- We were reconciled to God thru the Death of Jesus Christ, Romans 5:10
- Jesus died for mankind. 1 Thessalonians 5:9
- Jesus foretold that the Jewish people would put Him to death. Matthew 20:18
- The Jews put Jesus to death by hanging him on a cross. Acts 10:39
- The Israelites put Jesus to death. Acts 2:23, 36; Acts 4:10
- The Israelites put to death the "Prince of Life". Acts 3:15
- The life Jesus lives, He lives to God. Romans 6:10
- Jesus was delivered up because of our transgressions. Romans 4:25
- Jesus died. Romans 8:31, 34; Romans 14:9
- Jesus humbled Himself to even die on the cross. Philippians 2:8
- Jesus reconciles us in His fleshly body through death. Colossians 1:22
- Jesus abolished death and brought life & immortality to light thru the gospel.
 2 Timothy 1:10
- Jesus suffered death. Hebrews 2:9
- Death is no longer master over Jesus-but it was at one time. Romans 6:9
- Jesus death took place for the redemption for transgressions committed under the 1st Covenant (I.e. Law of Moses). Hebrews 9:15
- The rich condemned and put to Death Jesus, the righteous man. James 5:6
- Herod found Jesus had done nothing deserving of death. Luke 23:15, 22
- God was able to save Jesus from the crucifixion, but He didn't for our sake. Heb. 5:7
- Jesus was put to death in the flesh. 1 Peter 2:18
- Jesus died before the Jewish Sabbath day. John 19:31-33
- Jesus died for my sins. 1 Corinthians 15:3
- Jesus will never die again. Romans 6:9
- Thru death Jesus rendered powerless him who HAD the power of death—that is the devil. Hebrews 2:14
- For where a covenant is, there must of necessity be the death of the one who
 made it. A covenant is valid ONLY when men are dead. A covenant is never
 in force while the one who made it lives. Hebrews 9:17
- Jesus put to death the Law of Moses (I.e. enmity) by the cross. Ephesians 2:16
- Jesus "nailed" the Law of Moses "to the cross". Colossians 2:14
- A saved man must believe that Jesus died and rose again. 1 Thessalonians 4:14

JESUS' RESURRECTION!

- Jesus Christ foretold that He would rise from the dead. Mark 9:9; Mark 10:33-34; 14:27; Luke 9:22; John 2:22
- Jesus was raised, sits at the right hand of God, far above all rule and authority, and intercedes for us. Romans 8:34; Ephesians 1:20-21
- Because of Jesus resurrection from the dead, He was the 1st to proclaim light to both Jews and Gentiles. Acts 26:23
- We shall receive righteousness <u>IF</u> we believe in God who raised Jesus from the dead. Romans 4:24
- We are born again to a living hope thru the resurrection of Jesus from the dead, to obtain an imperishable inheritance. 1 Peter 1:3
- Jesus said the Law of Moses, Prophets, & the Psalms must be fulfilled—including the prophecy about His death. Luke 24:44-47
- Christ lived again after His death. Romans 14:9
- Jesus Christ was raised from the dead. John 2:22; Romans 6:4, 9; 7:4; 8:34;
 1 Corinthians 15:12, 1 Corinthians 15:20; 2 Timothy 2:8
- God brought up from the dead the great Shepherd of the sheep through the blood of the covenant. Hebrews 13:20
- God raised Jesus from the dead. Acts 2:32; 4:10; 5:30; 13:30, 33-34; Romans 8:11;
 1 Corinthians 6:14; 2 Corinthians 3:14; 4:11; Galatians 1:1; Ephesians 1:20;
 Colossians 2:12; 1 Thessalonians 1:10; 2 Thessalonians 1:10
- · God raised Jesus up again and put an end to the agony of Death. Acts 21:24
- God raised the Prince of life from the dead. Acts 3:15
- God raised Jesus so He did not undergo decay and would never decay. Acts 13:33-37
- God raised Jesus from the dead and gave Him glory. 1 Peter 1:21
- God raised Jesus from the dead on the third day. Acts 10:40
- God has proven that Jesus Christ. will judge the world by Jesus' resurrection from the dead. Acts 17:30-31
- The disciples were witnesses to Jesus' resurrection. Acts 3:15
- After Jesus had arisen, His apostles could tell of the vision at the transfiguration.
 Matthew 17:9
- When the guards saw the angels at Jesus' resurrection, they became like dead men. Matthew 28:3
- The angels told the 2 Mary's that Jesus had risen from the dead. Matthew 28:7
- Jesus was "declared the Son of God with power by the resur. from the dead." Romans 1:4
- Jesus was "raised because of our justification". Romans 4:25
- Jesus rose from the dead the third day. Matthew 16:21; Luke 24:26; 1 Corinthians 15:4
- The apostles ate and drank with Jesus after he arose from the dead, and became His witnesses. Acts 4:2: 10:41
- God proved that Jesus would judge the world in righteousness by raising Him from the dead. Acts 17:31
- Jesus having been raised from the dead, is NEVER to die again. Romans 6:9
- Jesus was made alive to the spirit. 1 Peter 2:18
- Paul asserted Jesus to be alive—and not dead. Acts 25:19



Jesus was "buried". Romans 6:4; 1 Corinthians 15:4

Jesus was laid "in a tomb". Matthew 27:59; Mark 15:46; 16:2ff; Luke 23:53ff; John 19:41ff; Acts 13:29

Jesus did NOT undergo decay. Acts 2:31; 13:37

Jesus was not abandoned to Hades. Acts 2:31
