
MAN'S DEATH to Self and to Sin...

- We die with Christ. Romans 6:8
- Our "old self was crucified with Jesus, that our body of sin might be done away with". Romans 6:5-6
- We are buried with Jesus in baptism, in which you are raised up with Jesus through faith. Colossians 2:2
- We have "been buried with Jesus thru baptism into death, in order that...we too might walk in newness of life". Romans 6:4-5
- When we die to sin, we should not continue to live in it. Romans 6:2
- All of us who have been baptized into Jesus have been baptized into His death. Romans 6:3
- Paul was conformed to Jesus' death in order to attain to the resurrection of the dead. Philippians 3:10-11
- The law proved to result in death—instead of life. Romans 7:10
- "...lay aside the old self, which is being corrupted in accordance with the lusts of deceit..." Ephesians 4:22
- Jesus reconciles us in His fleshly body through death. Colossians 1:22
- Jesus bore our sins in His body on the cross, that man might die to sin.
 1 Peter 2:24
- Paul asks' this rhetorical question: "How shall we who died to sin still live in it?" Romans 6:2
- He who has died is freed from sin. Romans 6:7
- IF we die with Jesus, we believe we will also live with Him. Romans 6:8
- We are to consider ourselves to be dead to sin. Romans 6:11
- Believer's are made to die to the Law thru the body of Jesus so that they might be joined to Him. Romans 7:4
- If you are living according to the flesh, you MUST die IF you want to live.
 Romans 8:12-13
- The Ephesian believers were dead in their trespasses and sins prior to becoming Christians. Ephesians 2:1
- When we were dead in our transgressions, we were made alive together with Christ. Ephesians 2:1
- We are "conformed to Jesus' death". Philippians 3:10
- We "die". Colossians 3:1

MAN'S NEW LIFE

- We are to "become united with Jesus" in the "likeness of His resurrection". Romans 6:5
- · We are "raised up with Jesus through faith in the working of God". Colossians 2:12
- · Christian's are to "arise from the dead". Ephesians 5:14
- · We now "walk in newness of life". Romans 6:4
- Jesus said unless one is born again (born of water and the Spirit), he cannot enter the kingdom of God. John 3:3-5
- We are "born again to a living hope through the resurrection of J.C. from the dead", which results in an inheritance that will "not fade away".
- "Therefore if any man is in Christ, he is a new creature; the old things passed away; behold, new things have come." 2 Corinthians 5:17
- Present "yourselves to God as those alive from the dead". Romans 6:13
- Once you have "died", your "life is hidden with Christ in God". Colossians 3:3
- We now live with Christ. Romans 6:8
- When we have "died to sin" we should NOT "still live in it". Romans 6:2
- He "who has died is freed from sin". Romans 6:7
- We should "no longer [to] be slaves to sin". Romans 6:6
- · Consider "yourselves to be dead to sin". Romans 6:11
- We are to consider ourselves as "alive to God in Christ Jesus". Romans 6:11
- We are now "freed from sin and enslaved to God" → sanctification → eternal life. Rom. 6:22
- Now we are "slaves of righteousness" since we have been freed from sin. Romans 6:17-18
- No longer present the members of your body to sin—as instruments of unrighteousness.
 Romans 6:13
- Believer's are made to die to the Law thru the body of Jesus so that they might be joined to Jesus. Romans 7:4
- You "are not under law, but under grace". Romans 6:14-15
- We have been released from the Law, having died to the Old Law. Romans 7:6
- We now "serve in newness of the Spirit and not in oldness of the letter". Romans 7:6
- IF Jesus is in you (though the body is dead because of sin) the spirit is alive. Romans 8:10
- If you are living by the Spirit you are putting to death the deeds of the body—and you will live.
 Romans 8:13
- The "spirit is alive because of righteousness". Romans 8:9
- God "made us alive together with Christ" and "raised us up with Him". We are saved by grace
 through faith, and it is a gift of God, and is not as a result of works. Ephesians 2:4-9
- We receive the "circumcision of Christ". Colossians 2:11
- When we are "raised up with Christ", we are to "keep seeking the things above". Col. 3:1
- Since **God raised Jesus** from the dead, our "**faith** and **hope** are in God". 1 Peter 1:21
- "...put on the new self, which in the likeness of <u>God</u> has been created in righteousness and holiness of the truth". Ephesians 4:24



Body of sin is done away with. Romans 6:6 We are "baptized into Jesus' death". Romans 6:3 Buried with Jesus through Baptism into death. Romans 6:4

We are "all **baptized into one body**" 1 Corinthians 12:13 and "**baptized into Christ**" Galatians 3:27
We are "**redeemed**" with the "**precious blood**" of the "unblemished and spotless" **lamb of God**. 1 Peter 1:18-19
