You can't begin to imagine how horrible that is and how very long eternity is! "And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death." "And He (Jesus) said, Verily (truly) I say unto you, Except ye be converted and become like little children, ye shall not enter into the kingdom of Heaven." Mat. 18:3

You must be born again. Jesus said, "Verily, (truly) verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God."
"Except a man be born of water and of the Spirit, He cannot enter into the kingdom of God."
"That which is born of the flesh is flesh; and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit." Marvel not that ye must be born again.
The wind bloweth where it will, and thou hearest the sound thereof, but canst not tell whence it cometh, and whither it goeth: so is every one that is born of the Spirit." John 3:3-8
This means that the wind results in a change.

This is Peter's first sermon after receiving the Holy Ghost himself:

"Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the Name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost."

"For the promise (the Holy Ghost) is unto you, and to your children, and to all that are afar off, even as many as the Lord our God shall call." Acts 2:38, 39

These past Scriptures explains how to be born again.

You must invite Jesus into your heart and sincerely repent of your sins. You must surrender your life to Him and ask Him to help you not to sin.

Then you must be baptized by immersion in Jesus Name, and you have the privilege of receiving the Gift of the Holy Ghost, or otherwise called the Holy Spirit. Some people receive it before they are baptized when worshipping but it is very necessary that you be baptized, too.

Saul was told upon his conversion to Christianity, "And now why tarriest thou? arise, and be baptized, and wash away thy sins, calling upon the Name of the Lord." Acts 22:16

About the Holy Spirit:

Jesus said, "If a son shall ask bread of any of you that is a father, will he give him a stone? or if he ask a fish, will he for a fish give him a serpent? Or if he shall ask an egg, will he offer him a scorpion?"

"If ye then, being evil, know how to give good gifts unto your children: how much more shall your Heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to them that ask Him?" Luke 11:11-13

"And these signs shall follow them that believe; In My Name shall they cast out devils;

they shall speak with new tongues! Mark 16:17 That is a Heavenly language given by Jesus!

It will fill you with joy unspeakable and you will never be the same again!

"In the last day, that great day of the feast, Jesus stood and cried, saying, If any man thirst, let him come unto Me and drink! He that believeth on Me, as the Scripture hath said, out of his belly shall flow rivers of living water. (But this spake He of the Spirit, which they that believe on Him should receive; for the Holy Ghost was not yet given, because Jesus was not yet glorified." John 7:37-39

Once you have done these things and have received Salvation you must continue to have a surrendered life to Jesus, reading and meditating on His Word, the Bible), daily, as best you can, so can learn how to act and think. "Study to show thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, right dividing the Word of Truth." II Timothy 2:15

What's the Bible for? "All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness." 2 Timothy 3:16
What are we to do? "But His (our) delight is in the law of the Lord; and in His law doth he (we) meditate day and night! Ps. 1:2 "Thy Word have I hid in mine heart, that I might not sin against thee. Ps. 119:11

How do we know that the Bible is the Truth? "Knowing this first, that no prophecy of the Scripture is of any private interpretation. For the prophecy came not in old time by the will of man: but holy men of God spake, (and it was written down) as they were moved by the Holy Ghost!" 2 Peter 1:20, 21

How do we know that it was preserved for us so that it is accurate? "The words of the Lord are pure Words: as silver tried in a furnace of earth, purified seven times. Thou shalt keep them, O Lord, thou shalt preserve them from this generation for ever!" Ps. 12:6, 7

God keeps His promises! He has preserved His Word for us to depend on for all the Truth of what He wants to say to you!

He has preserved His Word in the Authorized King James Bible. The translators did not add anything or delete anything but transferred it over word for word as near as they could from the original languages, not giving their own opinion of what it meant but keeping to what the writers were saying.

Studies have been done and it was found that even a fifth grader could understand it! Just ask Jesus to take the blinders off and help you understand it! As you read the Authorized King James Bible, (not the New King James) you will find that you can get deeper and deeper meaning as you read it more than one time.
