

THE HOLY GHOST FOR CHILDREN



The infilling of the Holy Ghost is for children, too! As soon as you can understand that you sin and you can say that you are sorry for your sins, you are old enough to pray for the Holy Ghost to come and live in you.

There are children as young as four years old that have been filled with the Holy Ghost. The Holy Ghost is the same thing as the Holy Spirit.

Receiving the Holy Ghost is the most wonderful thing that you can receive in this world!

It is Jesus' who fills you with His Holy Ghost and comes to live in you forever!

This is what the Bible says about Jesus baptizing you with the Holy Ghost, also called the Holy Spirit.:

John the Baptist said this, "I indeed have baptized you with water: but He (Jesus) shall baptize you with the Holy Ghost." St. Mark 1:8

In Acts 1:5, Jesus said to His Disciples, For John truly baptized with water; but ye shall be baptized with the Holy Ghost not many days from now.

The experience is also called "The Baptism of the Holy Spirit." It's not scary. It's a wonderful thing! The Holy Ghost is a wonderful, loving Spirit! He is Jesus' Spirit!

You can read in the Bible about how the disciples and about 105 others were filled with the Holy Ghost, too, and how they spoke in a language they didn't know. Mary, the mother of Jesus was one of them that was there to receive the Holy Ghost..

Read about it in Acts 2:1-4

Before Jesus went up into Heaven, He told the disciples to pray and wait for the Holy Ghost to come so that they could receive power and boldness to witness about Jesus to people. So they prayed for two weeks and than the Holy Ghost came and filled them.

They were filled with great joy when they received it! So much so that people who saw them thought that they were full of wine!

Being filled with the Holy Ghost makes you so very joyful, Honey! There were many other people filled with the Holy Ghost after that, and millions of people are still being filled today! So many you can't count them.

Jesus said in John 7:38 that when you receive the Holy Ghost "out of your belly shall flow rivers of living water!"

Doesn't that sound wonderful? Don't you want that too?

In verse 39 Jesus said that He was talking about the Holy Spirit.

Jesus said in John 3:3 that you must be "born again." And when you are born again you will speak in a Heavenly language as the Holy Spirit gives you the words.

Sometimes at first you will just make musical sounds, and then you will get words later.

It's just something you will really want to do so badly.

To speak out what the Holy Ghost gives you to say. Don't be worried about what it sounds like. Just speak out loud the words He puts in your mind.

Jesus says that you can ask Him to fill you with His wonderful Holy Spirit so that He can help you love Him more and to guide you to do the things He wants you to do. Sometimes when you are worshipping Him with all your heart He will just come and fill you with the Holy Spirit.



Otherwise to do this, is to talk to Him and tell Him how much you want Him with you all the time. You need to tell Him how much you love Him and to praise Him for being such a wonderful God.

Continue to do this over time until He comes and fills you. Don't give up praying for it. Jesus Will come and fill you when you continue to pray for it and tell Him how much you love Him, and mean it. He will give it to you when you are ready and Jesus knows when you are ready.

He loves you so much, Honey! And He wants you to have it more than you want it! He wants to fill you with joy and communion with Him! He wants to share His love with you and guide you in your everyday life. He can do that so much better when you are filled with the Holy Spirit.

Try to find someone else who believes in the infilling of the Holy Ghost." And ask them to lay their hands on you and pray with you for you to receive it.

Maybe you could get someone to take you to a full gospel church. That would be very helpful. If not, keep praying earnestly to receive the Holy Ghost.

Just give Jesus your whole heart and tell Him that you want to live for Him.

Be expecting for Him to fill you at any time and when it happens don't hesitate to speak out loud the words the Holy Ghost puts in your mind.

After you receive the Holy Ghost find some time to be with Him everyday and spend time worshipping Him and loving Him. When you tell Him how much you love Him and praise Him you will find yourself speaking in tongues.

Tell Him about all your thoughts and wants and needs. Tell Him about all your troubles because He is very interested in hearing about them and will always help when you ask Him for help. He will always be on time with His answers to your prayers. Just trust Him! He is never too early or too late with His answers. He is always right on time! And He's never wrong!

It is very important that you get baptized in Jesus' Name in a place where you can go totally under the water. The Bible says that it represents Jesus death, burial and resurrection. You can read Romans 6:4 about this.



Baptism also represents washing away your sins. Acts 22:16 says to "arise, and be baptized, and wash away your sins, calling on the Name of the Lord."

Jesus wants you to be reading your Bible so that you can learn about Him and also to learn how to act and think. You need to obey what the New Testament says. That is so very important to obey Jesus all your life! The Authorized King James Bible is the best Bible. It is the only pure, unaltered Word of God. Try to get that one to read and study and ponder on.
