Feeding of the Four Thousand:

29 And Jesus departed from thence, and came nigh unto the sea of Galilee; and went up into a mountain, and sat down there. 30 And great multitudes came unto him, having with them those that were lame, blind, and dumb, maimed, and many others, and cast them down at Jesus' feet; and He healed them: inasmuch that the multitude wondered, when they saw the dumb to speak, the maimed to be whole, the lame to walk, and the blind to see: and they glorified the God of Israel.

32 Then Jesus called the disciples unto Him, and said, I have compassion on the multitude, because they continue with Me now three days, and have nothing to eat: and I will not send them away fasting, lest they faint in the way. 33 And the disciples said unto Him, Whence should we have so much bread in the wilderness, as to fill so great a multitude? 34 And Jesus saith unto them, How many loaves have ye? And they said, Seven, and a few little fishes." 35 And then He commanded the multitude to sit down on the ground. 36 And He took the seven loaves and the fishes, and gave thanks, and brake them, and gave to the disciples, and the disciples to the multitude. 37 And they did all eat and were filled: and they took up of the broken meat that was left seven baskets full. 38 And they that did eat were four thousand men, besides women and children. 39 And He sent away the multitude, and took ship, and came into the coasts of Magdala. Matthew 15:29-39

(to John the Baptist) And He took them and went aside privately into a desert place belonging to the city of Bethsaida. 11 And the people when they knew it followed Jesus: and He received them, and spake unto them of the kingdom of God, and healed them that had need of healing. 12 And when the day began to wear away, then came the twelve, and said unto Him, Send the multitude away, that they may go into the towns and country round about, and lodge, and get victuals: for we are here in a desert place. 13 But Jesus said unto them, "Give them to eat." And they said, We have no more but five loaves and two fishes; except we should go and buy meat for all the people. 14 For they were about five thousand men. And Jesus said to His disciples, "Make them sit down by fifties in a company." 15 And they did so, and made them all sit down.

32 And they departed into a desert place by ship privately. 33 And the people saw them departing, and many knew Him, and ran afoot thither out of all cities, and outwent them, and came together unto Him. 34 And Jesus, when He came out, saw much people, and was moved with compassion toward them, because they were as sheep not having a shepherd: and He began to teach them many things. 35 And when the day was now far spent, His disciples came unto Him, and said, This is a desert place, and now the time is far passed:

36 Send them away, that they may go into the country round about, and into the villages, and buy themselves bread: for they have nothing to eat. 37 Jesus answered and said unto them, "Give ye to eat." And the disciples said unto Him; Shall we go and buy two hundred pennyworth of bread, and give them to eat? 38 And Jesus said unto them, "How many loaves have ye? go and see." And when they knew, they said, Five, and Two fishes. 39 Jesus commanded them to make all sit down by companies upon the green grass. 40 And they sat down in ranks, by hundreds, and by fifties. 41 And when He had taken the five loaves and the two fishes, He looked up to heaven, and blessed, and broke the loaves, and gave them to His disciples to set before them; and the two fishes divided He among them all. 42 And they did all eat, and were filled. 43 And they took up twelve baskets full of fragments, and of the fishes. 44 And they that did eat of the loaves were about five thousand men. 45 And straightway Jesus constrained His disciples to get into the ship, and to go to the other side before unto Bethsaida, while He sent away the people. 46 And when He had sent them away, Jesus went into a mountain to Pray.
