

JESUS NEEDS YOUR HELP



Jesus is no longer present in body on this earth. He has gone to Heaven and is guiding people through His Holy Spirit.

He needs you to be His hands and feet now! He wants you to be Jesus to people! He has given us the responsibility to reach the lost souls who need Him and Salvation. We don't do this by ourselves but He gives us the means and the power to do it.

If we fully give our life to Jesus and follow Him we will find that we love others and will want to love them more, and help reach lost souls for Him.

If we want to learn how to love others more and have a greater desire to help Jesus help others be reached and saved, we need only to ask Him and He will bring you to that place where you will be able to do it. If you want Jesus to help us to **make time** so that you can do these things, we need only ask Him. He will answer all your sincere prayers. You are not just left on your own to do anything we ask Him for by yourself.

To be truly effective we need the "Baptism of the Holy Ghost." It gives you a much greater love for Jesus and power and boldness to witness for Him. We must ask for the Holy Ghost. We don't receive it automatically. Luke 11:13 says, "How much more shall your Heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to them that **ask** Him."

Before the apostles could go out and witness Jesus told them that they must pray and tarry until they received the promise of the Holy Ghost.

He said, "For John truly baptized with water; but ye shall be **baptized** with the Holy Ghost not many days hence." Acts 1:4, 5

This wasn't just for the apostles. It was also for all the disciples; that is anyone who wants to witness for Jesus. Read the first half of Acts and you will learn that many types of people received the "Baptism of the Holy Ghost", Samaritans, Gentiles, Cornelius, other disciples and more.

Cornelius was told by an angel that he needed to speak to Peter to learn what to do to be saved although he was already loving God and serving Him. Peter said you must be baptized and filled with the Holy Ghost, and he obeyed him. Acts 10 and 11

We must be baptized by immersion in Jesus Name, for that is the saving Name, not Father, Son, and Holy Ghost. Jesus died for our sins; not the Father or the Holy Ghost.

That's how they baptized in the book of Acts; in Jesus name. They understood Jesus right in Matthew 28:19 that the **Name** (singular) of the Father, Son and Holy Ghost is **Jesus!** Read that verse again.

Peter didn't preach his first sermon until He received the Holy Ghost. The sermon was, "Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost." "For the promise (the Holy Spirit) is unto you, and to your children, and to **all** that are afar off, even as many as the Lord shall call." Acts 2:38, 39

In Acts 16 the Bible says that the first thing Paul was commanded to do upon receiving his sight was, "And now why tarriest thou? **arise**, and be baptized, and wash away thy sins, calling on the Name of the Lord."

When the jailer saw Paul and Silas released in prison by an earthquake when they sang and praised God in their misery; the jailer said, "Sirs, what must I do to be saved." Acts 16 When they had told Him to believe, and "spake the Word of God unto him," they took him the same hour down to the river and baptized him! It must be pretty important!

You aren't a candidate for baptism until you can understand enough to believe in Jesus and sincerely be sorry for your sins. If you have been baptized as an infant, you need to be baptized again if you believe in Jesus and are sorry for your sins and will try, with the help of Jesus not to sin.

Once you have obeyed the gospel you **really** are empowered to witness for Jesus!

Than you must continue seeking His face, daily and read and ponder on the Word of God for learning and guidance on how to follow and obey Him. He will help us do that if we continue to stay in His Word and seek His help in doing the things He wants us to do. He didn't leave us helpless! He gave us His Word, the Bible, as a guide to follow. He has given us the King James Bible. It is the only pure, unaltered Word of God. That is the one we should be reading. Get yourself a Strong's Concordance of the Bible, too, so you can find the real meaning of what some words mean from the Greek and Hebrew.

You shouldn't want man's opinion of what the Bible is saying as are described in other versions of the Bible. You want to know what God says in His Word. You will find it all in the King James Bible.

He loves you more than you can imagine, and He is so pleased when we search the Bible for all Truth and guidance in how to think and act. Reading it can bring great comfort and reassurance of His love for us, if you will just believe what it's saying.
