Or what if you had a “life map” that helped you to navigate where you go, and how to get there, for your most meaningful life? Life is difficult to navigate, but **God has a personal navigation tool for you.** God wants to give you both a life map and a “voice” to guide you at each turn. **Getting There:** For me, I’m not very good at directions; so when GPS (Global Positioning System) came out, I was thrilled. If you are unfamiliar with this, a GPS is a tool that takes a map of the world, narrows it down to streets and landmarks, and tells you exactly “where you are” how to get “where you want to go.” You click a button and it shows you all the landmarks around you.

And then you enter in your final destination, and a voice, or written Instructions, tell you just how to get there. **This is what I need in life, and you probably feel the same way. Your own GPS:** Did you know that God has given you your own GPS for life? It’s God’s Personal Support, through the Holy Bible and the guidance of His Holy Spirit. The Bible is the map, and God’s Holy Spirit is the “voice”. He wants to lead you at every life turn, every unknown situation, right until you reach His Promised Land.
