Luke 4:6: “And the devil said unto him, All this power will I give Thee, and the glory of them: for what is delivered to m; and to whomsoever I will, I give it.”

Sinners under the Dominion of:

Acts 26:18: To open their eyes, and to turn them from darkness to light, and from the power of Satan unto God, that they may receive forgiveness of sins, and inheritance among them which are sanctified by faith that is in me.”
