SO, WHAT IF THIS IS YOUR LAST DAY ON EARTH?



Maybe someone has told you about how wonderful Jesus is and how wonderful it is love and serve Him. You may have said that is all well and good but as for me, I don't have time for such things.

For example, you have a baby and you are a full time student and you don't have any time at all for anything else, or your job seems to be taking up all of your time; or you are having to good a time living to worry about what might happen to you. You feel like death is a long way off.

But WAIT! THINK about it! What if this is your day of your life and you will step into Eternity unprepared? You aren't guaranteed your next breathe and then it will be too late to make sure you are forgiven of your sins and right with Jesus!

Have you ever heard that Jesus said you have to be "born again?"

John 3:5 Truly, Truly I say unto thee, Except a man be born again (regenerated, conceived) he cannot see the kingdom of God.

V 6 "That which is born of the flesh is flesh (human nature, carnally minded) and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit. (Christ's Spirit, the Holy Spirit)

V8 "The wind bloweth where it pleases, and thou hearest the sound thereof, but canst not tell whence it cometh, and whither it goeth: so is every one that is born of the Spirit."

The result of the wind is a change. When you are born again you have a regenerated heart and you are a new creature in Christ!

We are born in sin with a human nature and separated from from God. Psalm 51:5 "Behold, I was shapen in iniquity: and in sin did my mother conceive me."

We need Christ's Spirit to regenerate us so that we are of the Spirit.

To be born again, this is what we must do:

That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised Him (Jesus) from the dead, thou shalt be saved."

"For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto Salvation!" Romans 10:9, 10

Here's how to get the faith needed to do this:
Read the Word of God and believe what you are reading and go and hear the Word of God preached or taught to you by a believer. They can help you understand it better.
Romans 10:17 "So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the Word of God."

Then you could pray this:

"Lord Jesus, have mercy on me, a Sinner.
"I believe in You and that your Word is true.
I believe that You are the Son of the Living God and that You died on the Cross so that I may now have forgiveness for my sins and Eternal Life.

Please Lord Jesus forgive me and come into my heart as my personal Lord and Savior today.

I need you to be my Father and Friend. I give you my life, and ask you to take full control from this moment!

I pray this in the Name of Jesus. Amen.

If you have prayed this sincerely you can be assured that you are born again.

Now you are ready to receive the Holy Spirit with evidence of speaking in tongues.

Just start praying that Jesus will come and fill you with His wonderful Spirit. Be worshipping Him sincerely and telling Him how much you love Him.

When He feels that you are ready He will come and fill you. It may be right away or it may take some time. It might not happen the same day or even for awhile.

You need to keep pressing in and seeking it. Jesus is faithful. If you are praying for it and really want it, He will come and fill you.
When you ask Him for something

He is not going to give you something evil!

In Luke 11:11-13 Jesus said about the Holy Spirit, "If a son shall ask bread of any of you that is a father, will he give him a stone? or if he ask a fish, will he for a fish give him a serpent? Or if he shall ask an egg, will he off him a scorpion?"
"If ye then, being evil, know how to give good gifts unto your children: how much more shall your Heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to them that ask Him!

When He fills you there may be some strange words that form in your mind. Just speak them out and you will speaking in tongues! Congratulations!

You need to find a Full Gospel Church to go to get baptized by immersion according to the teaching in the Bible. They will welcome you with open arms and help you get the basic knowledge of the Bible. We are to be constantly reading our Bibles so that we can learn to obey what it says.
