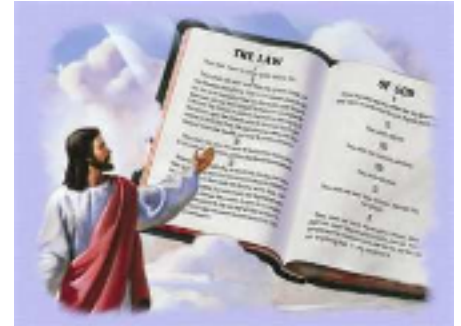
“For this is the love of God, that we keep His commandments: and His commandments are not grievous.” 1 John 5:3

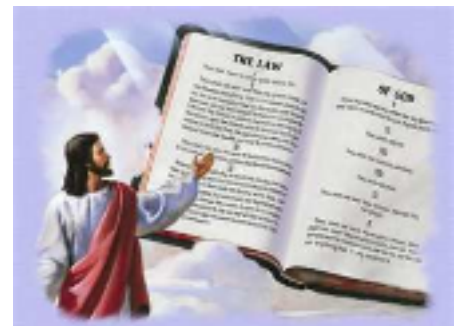
