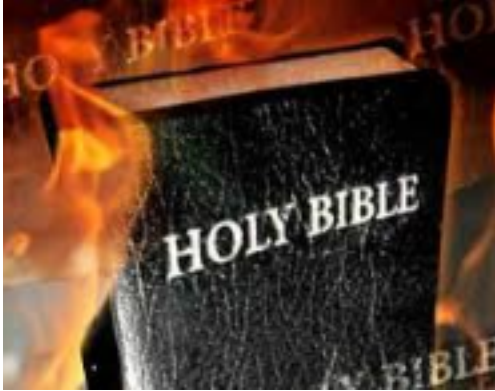


The Wicked: “God is Angry with the Wicked Every Day” Ps.7:11



What does wicked mean? Strong's Concordance: Wicked 7563—morally wrong, actively bad, ungodly, guilty, condemned & in New Testament: 4189—Depravity, esp. malice, maker of plots, in iniquity, sin. You can pick out and mark the ones you want to refer to again.

“The wicked shall be turned into Hell and all them that forget God.” Ps. 9:17 “He will keep the feet of his saints, and the wicked shall be silent darkness; for by strength no man shall prevail.” “The adversaries of the Lord shall be broken to pieces. out of heaven shall He thunder upon them; the Lord shall judge the ends of the earth...”

1 Samuel 2:9-10 “There (Heaven) the wicked shall cease from troubling; and there the weary shall be at rest.” Job 3:17

“They that hate thee shall be clothed with shame; and the dwellingplace of the wicked shall come to nought.” Job 8:22 “But the eyes of the wicked shall fail, and they shall not escape, and their hope shall be as the giving up of the ghost.” Job 11:20 Yea, the light of the wicked shall be put out, and the spark of his fire shall not shine.” Job 18:5

“Surely such are the dwellings of the wicked, and this is the place of him that knoweth not God.” Job. 18:21 “The triumphing of the wicked is short, and the joy of the hypocrite but for a moment?” Job 20:5 He preserveth not the life of the wicked: but giveth right to the poor.” Job 36:6

“God judgeth the righteous, and God is angry with the wicked every day.”

“The wicked plotteth against the just, and gnasheth upon him with his teeth.” Ps. 37:12

“A little that a righteous man hath is better than the riches of many wicked.” “For the arms of the wicked shall be broken: but the Lord uplifteth the righteous.” Ps. 37:16-17 “The wicked borroweth, and payeth not again; but the righteous showeth mercy, and giveth.” Ps. 37:21 “For the Lord loveth judgment, and forsaketh not his saints; they are preserved for ever; but the seed of the wicked shall be cut off.” Ps. 37:28 “But the transgressors shall be destroyed together: the end of the wicked shall be cut off.” Ps. 37:38

“But unto the wicked God saith, What has thou to do to declare my statutes, or that thou shouldest take my covenant in thy mouth?” “Seeing thou hatest instruction, and castest my words behind thy back!” Ps. 50:16-17

“Now consider this, ye that forget God, lest I tear you in pieces, and there be none to deliver!” Ps. 50:22 “The wicked are estranged from the womb: they go astray as soon as they be born, speaking lies.” Ps. 58:3

“And a fire was kindled in their company; the flame burned up the wicked.” Ps. 106:18

“The wicked shall see it, and be grieved; he shall gnash with his teeth, and melt away; the desire of the wicked shall perish.” Ps. 111:10 “Thou putteth away all the wicked like dross: therefore I love thy testimonies.” Ps. 119:119

“Salvation is far from the wicked: for they seek not thy statutes.” Ps.

119:155 “The Lord is righteous: He hath cut asunder the cords of the wicked.” Ps. 129:4

“The Lord preserveth all them that love Him: but all the wicked will He destroy!” Ps. 145:20 “The Lord preserveth the strangers; He relieveth the fatherless and the widow: but the way of the wicked He turneth upside down!” Ps. 146:9

“But the wicked shall be cut off from the earth, and the transgressors shall be rooted out of it.” Prov. 2:22 **“The way of the wicked is as darkness; for they know not at what they stumble.”**

Prov. 5:22 “A naughty person, a wicked man, walketh with a froward mouth.” Prov. 6:12 One of the seven things God hates: An heart that deviseth wicked imaginations.” Prov. 6:18 “The Lord will not suffer the soul of the righteous to famish: but He casteth away the substance of the wicked.”

“Blessings are upon the head of the just: but violence covereth the mouth of the wicked.” **“The memory of the just is blessed: but the name of the wicked shall Rot!”** “The mouth of a righteous man is a well of life: but violence covereth the mouth of the wicked.” “The labour of the righteous tendeth to life: the fruit of the wicked to sin.” Prov. 10:3, 6-7, 11,16

“The tongue of the just is as choice silver: the heart of the wicked is of little worth!” **“The fear of the Lord prolongeth days: but the years of the wicked shall be shortened.”** **“The righteous shall never be moved: but the wicked shall not inhabit the earth.”** **The lips of the righteous know what is acceptable: but the mouth of the wicked speaketh forwardness.”** Prov. 10:20, 27, 30, 32

“The fear of the wicked, it shall come upon him: but the desire of the righteous shall be granted.” “As a whirlwind passeth, so is the wicked no more: but the righteous is an everlasting foundation!” Prov. 10:24-25

“The righteousness of the perfect (sincerely sound, undefiled, without spot) shall direct his way: but the wicked shall fall by his own wickedness.” “The righteous is delivered out of trouble, and the wicked cometh in his stead.” Prov. 11:5, 8

“When it goeth well with the righteous, the city rejoiceth: and when the wicked perish, there is shouting!” Prov. 11:10 “By the blessing of the upright the city is exalted: but it is overthrown by the mouth of the wicked.” Pr. 11:11

“The wicked worketh a deceitful work: but to him that soweth righteousness shall be sure reward!” **“Though hand join in hand, the wicked shall not be unpunished: but the seed of the righteous shall be delivered.”** “The desire of the righteous is only good: but the expectation of the wicked is wrath.”

“Behold, the righteous shall be recompensated in the earth: much more the wicked and the sinner.” Prov. 11:18,21,23,31

“A good man obtaineth favour of the Lord: but a man of wicked devices will He condemn.” “A man shall not be established by wickedness: but the root of the righteous shall not be moved.” “The thoughts of the righteous are right: but the counsels of the wicked are deceit.” “The words of the wicked are to lie to wait for blood: but the mouth of the upright shall deliver them.” “The wicked are overthrown, and are not: but the house of the righteous shall stand!” “A righteous man regardeth the life of his beast: but the tender mercies of the wicked are cruel!”

“The wicked desireth the evil men: but the root of the righteous yieldeth fruit.” “The wicked is snared by the transgression of his lips; but the just shall come out of trouble!” “There is no evil happen to the just: but the wicked shall be filled with mischief.” Prov. 2-3, 5-7,10,12-13,21

“A righteous man hateth lying: but a wicked man is loathsome, and cometh to shame!” “The light of the righteous rejoiceth: but the lamp of the wicked shall be put out!” A wicked messenger falleth into mischief: but a faithful ambassador is health!” “The righteous eateth to the satisfying of his soul: but the belly of the wicked shall want.” Prov. 13:5,9,17,25

“The house of the wicked shall be overthrown: but the tabernacle of the upright shall flourish!” **“He that is soon angry dealeth foolishly: and a man of wicked devices is hated.”** “The wicked bow before the good; and the wicked at the gates of the righteous.” The wicked is driven away in his own wickedness: but the righteous hath hope in his death.” Prov. 14:11,17,19,32

“In the house of the righteous is much treasure: but in the revenues of the wicked is trouble.” “The sacrifice of the wicked is an abomination to the Lord; but the prayer of the upright is His delight!” “The thoughts of the wicked are an abomination to the Lord: but the words of the pure are pleasant words.” **“The heart of the righteous studieth to answer: but the mouth of the wicked poureth out evil things!”** “The Lord is far from the wicked: but He heareth the prayer of the righteous.” Prov. 15:6,8-9,26,28,29

“The wicked doer giveth heed to false lips; and a liar giveth ear to a naughty tongue.” “He that justifieth the wicked, and he that condemneth the just, even they both are abominations to the Lord.” “A wicked man taketh a gift out of the bosom to pervert the ways of judgment.” Prov. 17:4,15,23

“When the wicked cometh, then cometh also contempt, and with ignominy reproach.” “It is not good to accept the person of the wicked, to overthrow the righteous in judgment.” Prov. 18:3,5 “An ungodly witness scorneth judgment: and the mouth of the wicked devoureth iniquity.” Prov. 19:28 “A wise king scattereth the wicked, and bringeth the wheel over them.” Prov. 20:26 “An high look, and a proud heart, and the plowing of the wicked, is sin.” “The robbery of the wicked shall destroy them; because they refuse to do judgment.” Prov. 21:4,7 “The soul of the wicked desireth evil: his neighbor findeth no favour in his eyes.” “The righteous man wisely considereth the house of the wicked; but God overthroweth the wicked for their wickedness.” “The wicked shall be a ransom for the righteous, and the transgressor for the upright.” Prov. 21:10,12,18 “The sacrifice of the wicked is abomination: how much more, when he bringeth it with a wicked mind!” “A wicked man hardeneth his face: but as for the upright, He directeth his path.” Prov. 21:27,29

“Lay not, O wicked man, against the dwelling of the righteous; spoil not his resting place.” For a just man falleth seven times and riseth up again: but the wicked shall fall into mischief.” Prov. 24:16-17 “Fret not thyself because of evil men, neither be thou envious at the wicked; For there shall be no reward to the evil man; and the candle of the wicked shall be put out!” Prov. 24:19-20 “He that saith unto the wicked, Thou art righteous; him shall the people curse, nations shall abhor him: But to them that rebuke him shall be delight, and a good blessing shall come upon thee!” Prov. 24:24-25

“Take away the wicked from before the king, and his throne shall be established in righteousness.” “A righteous man falling down before the wicked is as a troubled fountain, and a corrupt spring.” Prov. 25:5,26 “Burning lips and a wicked heart are like a potsherd covered with silver dross.” Prov. 26:23

“The wicked flee when no man pursueth: but the righteous are bold as a lion!”

Prov. 28:1 “They that forsake the law praise the wicked: but such as keep the law contend with them.” “Evil men understand not judgment: but they that seek the Lord understand all things!” Prov. 28:4-5

“When the righteous men do rejoice, there is great glory: but when the wicked rise, a man is hidden.” “As a roaring lion, and a ranging bear; so is a wicked ruler over the poor people.” “When the wicked rise, men hide themselves.” 28:12,15,28

“When the righteous are in authority, the people rejoice! But when the wicked beareth rule, the people mourn.” **“The righteous considereth the cause of the poor: but the wicked regardeth not to know it!”** “If a ruler hearken to lies, all his servants are wicked.” “When the wicked are multiplied, transgression increaseth, but the righteous shall see their fall.” Prov. 29:2,7,12,16
