I was only six weeks along and thought it might be okay to have the abortion since it probably wasn't formed, but I knew in my heart that it was wrong. I felt there was no other choice. I felt my life would be over and ruined if I had this baby.

When I got home the grief started in force! I grieved and travailed for my baby so loud that the neighbors heard me! I lived in a trailer house, and the people across the street heard me. I cried out "my baby, my baby, I want my baby" all night! Even my little son, Hans heard me. I knew it was a baby and now I would never know it. I loved babies...I had always loved babies and now I was asking myself, What had I done! I had murdered my own child and sinned against God! We all should really think before we act!

I just went on after that, feeling my parents would now never find out but afraid they would somehow find out what I had done. I lived in fear of that, thinking, what if my parents found out I went a long ways away that day. And my mother **did** try to find out where I was the day of the abortion.

Again, I buried all the feelings after that for the next twenty five years not thinking much about it but I felt dirty inside without really realizing it. I was divorced and had had two other children before this. I found my second husband at a bar but since I had prayed for God to send me a husband that would love me the rest of my life no matter what I had to go through, He turned out to be a loving, faithful husband, although we did have problems.

I could never seem to find peace and contentment. I was always striving inside. I felt lost even with my family. I had two more children and raised them with the other two.


After my kids were fully grown and leaving home I asked God to lead them to Him. He led them to a Pentecostal Church where they found salvation! Than they came and told me about it and they led me there to be saved!

For the past three years before that I had started searching for a church to go to where I could find what I was looking for. I was looking for God in these churches and I wasn't finding Him. They had me in for counseling. And as my grief poured out the Presence of the Lord was very heavy in the room. Over a period of a couple of months the grief continued to pour out of me over losing my baby and I expressed my guilt for what I had done.

Finally, I was actually able to receive, in my heart, God's forgiveness! Shortly after that I organized a funeral for my baby. I bought a little Bible to remember him or her by, and even named the baby with a girl and boy's name, and we had the service. We sang a few hymns, expressing God's great love for us, and we each said a few words about the baby. Than, everyone wrote something in the little Bible about the baby. I found healing and peace, at last! I knew I would see her or him in Heaven someday!



God said in His Word, the Bible, that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost and it belongs to God. We don't have the right to choose what to do with it.
