”For they heard them speak with tongues, and magnify God!”  
”Then in Acts 19 Paul said to the people there “Have ye received the Holy Ghost since ye believed? And they said unto him, We have not so much as heard whether there by any Holy Ghost.”  
Verse 6: “And when Paul laid his hands upon them, the Holy Ghost came on them: and they spake with tongues and prophesied.”

Read all about how to be baptized in Acts 10:47, 48 and 19:3-5, and how Jesus was baptized in Matthew 3:16 and Mark 1:10. In addition read Mark 1:5, and John 3:23. Jesus and the apostles are our example of how to baptize. We are to be baptized in Jesus Name by immersion.  
We are only to be baptized when we are old enough to know what sin is and be able to repent for our sins and commit our life to Christ. In Chapter 9 Paul was baptized and received the Holy Ghost and then he was sent out to preach the gospel.  
Having the Baptism of the Holy Ghost can make you bold enough to go and tell everyone about Jesus when before you felt like you just weren’t brave enough to do it.  
Acts 2:16-18 says that Jesus is still pouring out His Spirit upon all people:  
”And it shall come to pass in the last days (the last days started after Jesus rose from the dead) saith God, I will pour out of My Spirit upon all flesh: and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, and your young men shall see visions, and your old men shall dream dreams: and on My handmaidens I will pour out in those days of My Spirit; and they shall prophesy...  
Pouring out His Spirit means being filled with the Holy Ghost and speaking with tongues as the Spirit gives the utterance.

The Baptism of the Holy Ghost, in other words being filled with His Spirit is the most wondrous thing that you can receive on Earth in addition to receiving Jesus Christ as your Saviour! It brings you more joy than you can take in, if you continue to seek fellowship with Jesus and keep reading and studying and pondering in your Bible, and keep obeying what you read. Most of what we obey is written in the New Testament. We don’t obey the old laws anymore, but there are great riches in the Old Testament too.  
The Holy Ghost guides and teaches you and gives you comfort. It holds you up spiritually when you are too weak to stand on your own.
