Lets look at another scripture that almost everyone is familiar with.

John 3:16 KJV

For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son that whosoever believeth in Him shall not perish but have everlasting life.

New King James Version For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son that who-ever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.

The Good News Bible For God loved the world so much that He gave His only Son, so that every one who believes in Him may not die but have eternal life.

The Living Bible
For God Loved the world so
much that He have his only
Son so that anyone who
believes in Him shall not
perish but have eternal life.

The wording may be a little different in these versions but the meaning comes across loud and clear in each. God Loves us He wants us to return to Him someday. He made a way for us. By sending His only Son to pay our way. And all you have to do is Believe in Him. Are you ready?
