


# Who is the Living God, and How to be Saved



“For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, what whosoever believeth in Him should not perish by have everlasting life.”

“For God sent not His Son into the world to condemn the world but that the world might be saved through Him.”

“He that believeth on the Son hath everlasting Life: and he that believeth not the Son shall not see Life; but the wrath of God abideth on Him.” John 3:16-17, 36

## Backing up a little we read:

“And the angel said unto Mary, Fear not Mary: for thou hast found favour with God; and behold, thou shalt conceive in thy womb, and bring forth a Son, and shalt call His Name JESUS.” Luke 1:30,31

An angel spoke to Joseph and said, “Fear not to take unto thee Mary thy wife: for that which is conceived in her is of the Holy Ghost.”

“And she shall bring forth a Son, and thou shalt call His Name JESUS: for He shall save His people from their sins.”

## After Jesus had grown up we read:

“The next day John (the Baptist) seeth Jesus coming unto him, and saith, Behold the Lamb of God, which taketh away the sins of the world.” John 1:29

Jesus came into Galilee, preaching the Gospel of the kingdom of God, saying, The time is at hand: Repent ye, and believe the Gospel.”

Mark 1:14-15 Jesus said, “I tell you, Nay: but except ye repent, ye shall all likewise perish.”

Luke 13:3 “God is Love.” 1 John 4:8 “Herein is Love, not that we loved God, but that He loved us, and sent His Son to be the propitiation (atonement, sacrifice) for our sins.” 1 John 4:10

God required punishment for sin when Adam and Eve fell into sin in the Garden of Eden in Genesis 1, and what is written by the prophets in the Old Testament, leads up to the Birth of Jesus which is recorded in the New Testament.

It was predicted in the Old Testament by the prophets and all was fulfilled as written in the New Testament.



## After Jesus had grown up we read:
