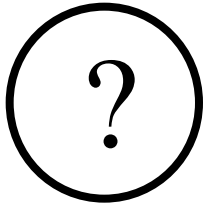


WHY YOU ARE ON EARTH

Jn 3: 16).

Do you know why you are still living and partly living? It is just because you are not fully representing Heaven or God. When you fully represent Him, then:...

Sickness will not be your worry for “Who his own self bare our sins in his own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: BY WHOSE STRIPES YE WERE HEALED.” 1Pet 2:24

Poverty will be very far from your doors since “For ye know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that, though he was rich, yet for your sakes he became poor, that ye through his poverty might be rich.” 2Cor 8:9. According as his divine power hath given unto us all things that *pertain* unto life and godliness, through the knowledge of him that hath called us to glory and virtue: (2Pe 1:3)

Fear for the unknown future will not be you portion for it is written, “For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, saith the LORD, thoughts of peace, and not of evil, to give you an expected end.” Jer 29:11
