



THE WORD OF GOD

The Word of God is the most powerful thing there is on this Earth! Reading, believing, pondering and obeying the Bible is the most necessary thing to do. It is the power of God unto Salvation! The Bible has much to say about the Words of God.

I am going to share some of it.

Here's what we need to do for one thing: to keep the Word of God as the apple of our eye! When we love and obey Him, He, keeps us as the apple of His eye! We are not only to obey the Commandments! We are to obey all the Commands of Jesus and the Epistles of the Apostles; and all Jesus' sayings as written in the gospels.

These are words for you:

"My son, attend to My Words; incline thine ear unto My sayings."

"Let them not depart from thine eyes; keep them in the midst of thine heart."

"For they are Life to those that find them, and health to all their flesh!"

"Keep thy heart with all diligence; for out of it are the issues of life."

Proverbs 4:20-23

"Let thine heart retain My Words: keep My Commandments, and live."

"Get wisdom, get understanding: forget it not; neither decline from the words of My mouth."

"Forsake her not, and she shall preserve thee: love her, and she shall keep thee."

"Wisdom is the principal thing; therefore get wisdom: and with all thy getting get understanding." Proverbs 4:4-7

"Hear, O my son, and receive my sayings; and the years of thy life shall be many."

"Take fast hold of instruction: let her not go: keep her; for she is thy life!"

"Enter not into the path of the wicked, and go not in the way of evil men."

Proverbs 4:10, 13, 14

There is much more if you read Proverbs!

 ”For wisdom is better than rubies; and all the things that may be desired are not to be compared to it!” Proverbs 8:8-11

“Buy the Truth, and sell it not; also wisdom, and instruction, and understanding!”
 Proverbs 23:23

“He that handleth a matter wisely shall find good: and whoso trusteth in the Lord, happy is he!”

“The wise in heart shall be called prudent: and the sweetness of the lips increaseth learning!” 16:20, 21

“He that is slow to anger is better than the mighty: and he that ruleth his spirit than he that taketh a city!” 16:32

There is nothing more important in life but these things! Jesus also said:
 “I love them that love Me; and those that seek Me early (diligently) shall find Me!”
 “Riches and honour are with Me; yea, durable riches and righteousness!”
 “That I may cause those to love Me to inherit substance: and I will fill their treasures.”
 Proverbs 8:17, 18, 21

“For whoso findeth Me findeth Life! and shall obtain favour of the Lord.”
 “But he that sinneth against Me wrongeth his own soul!” Proverbs 8:35, 36
 Further He said, “The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom: and the knowledge of the Holy is understanding!”

”He is in the way of life that keepeth instruction: but he that refuseth reproof erreth”

But He says, "The blessing of the Lord, it maketh rich, and He addeth no sorrow to it!"

"When a man's ways please the Lord, He maketh even his enemies to be at peace with him!" Proverbs 16:7

There are many promises in the Bible for those who love and obey him. He will watch over you and take care of you and answer your prayers. It may not seem like He is answering you but He will answer every sincere prayer just at the right time. He is never too early or too late in answering and He's always on time. And He's never wrong!

If your answer doesn't come that means He has something better for you that He is going to bring to pass.

You need to say, I can make it just a little longer and a little longer. Just keep going forward in faith and the Lord will lift you up, and make you stronger in what you are going through!

The Book of Psalms is just full of awesome promises and comfort from the Lord!
 Here’s one more Scripture in Proverbs 3:5, 6

 “In all thy ways, acknowledge Him, and He shall direct thy path!”

An even bigger key to receiving answers to your prayers is to praise and thank
 Him for all things no matter how bad they seem! Because Jesus will work
 everything for good that has happened in our life and what is happening now.
