

THE WORD OF GOD FOR YOUR HEALING



We LIMIT God when we fail to believe, think upon, and ACT upon His Word! He has given us the Authority to use it for what we need and want! He didn't leave us without help but it's necessary to apply His Word to our situation in order to receive it's promises.

God cannot lie and His Scripture is the Truth and is no lie! "It is impossible for God to lie! Hebrews 6:18, Titus 1:2. The Holy Bible has been preserved for our use because He loves us! Psalms 103 says "Bless the Lord Oh my soul and all that is within in me, Bless His Holy Name! and forget NOT ALL His BENEFITS! Who forgiveth all our sins, and who healeth ALL our DISEASES! Did you forget that you have BENEFITS? That you have great wealth in belonging to Jesus? You are His inheritance and His treasure! Great wealth isn't necessarily money, although you need money too, but the biggest treasures you can receive are peace, joy, thanksgiving in your heart, healing and everything promised in Gods' Word.

What do those scriptures mean? That we are to first of all love Jesus with all of our hearts and bless and thank Him for all things in our life, no matter how things look. And we can know that we can have literally ALL the Blessings of God that He promises in His Word! With nothing withheld. He wants to bless His Children, just like we do! "For the Lord God is a sun and a SHIELD; He will give graciousness and glory, NO GOOD THING will He WITHOLD from them that walk uprightly! Psalm 86:11 It is very important that you forgive everyone who you might have something against or be working with the Lord in accomplishing that.

You may be asking why don't so many people not get healed? Because they don't ACT on God's Word. They don't do what God wants them to do; to stand upon His Word and believe it will bring results. Or they give up after awhile and say "this doesn't work...I don't see anything." We live by faith and not by sight. And faith cometh by hearing and hearing and DOING the Word of God! We have to be consistent in our confession and be consistent and persistent. Keep knocking on Jesus' door and don't give up! Even if it's only one verse repeated in faith. And EXPECT Him to do what the Holy Bible says! Wait means Patiently Expect.

And it doesn't matter how long it takes for things to change. We need to be persistent and continually speak the healing Scriptures to ourselves and to Jesus, and get it way deep into our spirit. That kind of faith moves Jesus! We also need to speak the Scriptures back to the devil, as he is will always try to convince you that Jesus won't heal you. Say devil, "It is written" and then the scripture.

And find something to be thankful for everyday...be purposely thankful. There is always something to be thankful for. We can share the love of Jesus anytime, anywhere! We can find something positive to say even in the worst of circumstances and it will cheer you up!

"In everything give thanks, for this is the Will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you!" 1 Thessalonians 5:18

That might be hard to get out when you are suffering but Jesus will bring something good out of everything!

"And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are called according to His purpose." Romans 8:28 We are to "Be anxious for nothing (that's hard to do) but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known unto God!" Philippians 4:6 We have to work at it! "And the peace of God which passeth all understanding, shall keep all your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus!" Philippians 4:6-7

GOD IS YOUR REFUGE AND STRENGTH, AN EVER PRESENT HELP IN TROUBLE! Psalm 46:1 Using the Word of God this is what your confession can be like:

Bless the Lord, O my soul and all that is within in me, Bless His Holy Name, Bless the Lord and forget not all His benefits; who forgiveth all my iniquities, who healeth ALL my diseases, Who redeemeth my life from destruction; Who crowneth me with loving-kindness and tender mercies; Who satisfies my mouth with good things so that my youth is renewed like the eagles! Ps.103:1-6

"But my God shall supply all my need according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus...For He will restore health unto me and heal me of my wounds, saith the Lord... I will not be afraid of evil tidings, my heart is fixed, trusting in the Lord... For He healeth the broken in heart and bindeth up their wounds...I will live and not die but live to declare the works of the Lord...by His stripes I am healed...His Word shall not return unto Him void...Heal me, O Lord and I shall be healed...no weapon formed against me shall prosper...He will send His Word and heal me...no good thing will He withhold from them that walk uprightly...I am more than a conqueror through Christ who loves me...He will put strength in me...He Himself took my infirmities and bare my sicknesses...The fervent prayer of a righteous man availeth much...And the prayer of faith shall heal the sick and the Lord shall raise him up and if he hath committed sins they shall be forgiven.....Lord, speak the Word only and I shall be healed...I call those things which be not as though they were, I have God's promises of healing...If I abide in Him and His Words abide in me, I shall ask and whatsoever I ask, I shall receive of Him, because I keep His Commandments and do those things which are pleasing in His sight... I will attend to His Words, I will bless the Lord at all times, His praise shall continually be in my mouth..... I will hope in God, for I will praise Him, for He is the Health of my Countenance and my God... I will trust in the Lord with all mine heart and lean not unto mine own understanding...I will delight myself in the Lord and He will give me the desires of my heart

... I will rest in the Lord and wait patiently and expectantly on Him...nothing is too hard for God...For with God nothing is impossible...If I can believe all things are possible! I will speak to the mountain and not let the mountain speak to me... I am standing on God's Word and I won't give up no matter how I feel...I will keep His Word and meditate on it day and night...I am acting upon His Word and I will continue to act on His Word. His promises are true and I will continue to believe no matter what the circumstances. I will walk by faith and not by sight!
I will have a joyful heart and it will be medicine to me... A merry heart doeth good like a medicine!
Pleasant words are as a honeycomb...sweet to my soul, and health to my bones... What time I am afraid, I will trust in Thee...He will keep me in perfect peace because my mind is stayed on Him and I trust in Him. They that wait, patiently, expectantly, on the Lord shall renew their strength. They shall mount up with wings as eagles. They shall run and not be weary, they shall walk and not faint. Teach me Lord to be patient and to be expecting!
Under the shadow of thy wings will I make my refuge until these calamities be overpast! I will cry unto God most high; unto God that performeth ALL things for me!
Psalm 57:1, 2 These are just some of the awesome scriptures about receiving your healing. Here are some more: Be like Abraham: Who staggered not at the promises of God through unbelief! But was STRONG in FAITH, giving glory to God and was fully persuaded in his mind that what God had promised He was willing and able to perform! Romans 4:20, 21 And Further: Cast not away your CONFIDENCE which hath great recompense of REWARD! (healing) For you have need of PATIENCE, Patiently expecting, that after you have done the Will of God, you will receive the PROMISE! (healing) Hebrews 10:35, 36

But Thanks be to God, who giveth us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ! 1 Corinthians 15:57

"For if God be for us, WHO can be against us!

"He that spared not his own Son, but delivered Him up for us all, How shall He not FREELY give us all things!" Romans 3:31:32

Trust in Jesus...He has the right timing...He knows what He is doing and He's never wrong! "Trust in the Lord with all thine heart and LEAN NOT unto thine own understanding!" Commit thy way unto Him, trust also in Him and He will bring your healing to pass! Proverbs 3:5 and Psalms 37:5
Give Him time.

Another woman quoted this same verse who was dying of cancer and she fully recovered too! If you can only handle one verse... choose one verse and be faithful to applying that verse all the time. God's Word is powerful!
